Ephesians 4:14. In order that we should no longer be babes, tossed about as by waves and carried hither and thither by every wind of teaching by means of the trickery of men, by means of cunning in contriving error.

- This hope we have as an anchor for the soul, both sure and firm, and it enters in within the curtain. (Hebrews 6:19)
- But let him keep on asking in faith, not doubting at all, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven by the wind and blown about. (James 1:6)
- Let no man deprive YOU of the prize who takes delight in a mock humility and a form of worship of the angels, taking his stand on the things he has seen, puffed up without proper cause by his fleshly frame of mind. (Colossians 2:18)
- Do not be carried away with various and strange teachings, for it is fine for the heart to be given firmness by undeserved kindness, not by eatables, by which those who occupy themselves with them have not been benefited. (Hebrews 13:9)
- Accordingly, put away all badness and all deceitfulness and hypocrisy and envies and all sorts of backbiting. (1 Peter 2:1)
- For such men are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into apostles of Christ. (2 Corinthians 11:13)
- You have tossed away all those straying from your regulations, for their trickiness is falsehood. (Psalms 119:118)
- O Yehowah, do deliver my soul from false lips, from the tricky tongue. (Psalms 120:2)
- Like foxes in the devastated places are what your own prophets have become, O Israel. (Ezekiel 13:4)
- What, then, did you go out to see? A man dressed in soft garments? Why, those wearing soft garments are in the houses of kings. (Matthew 11:8)
- For you were bought with a price. By all means, glorify God in the body of you people. (1 Corinthians 6:20)

- Brothers, do not become young children in powers of understanding, but be babes as to badness, yet become full-grown in powers of understanding. (1 Corinthians 14:20)
- For everyone that partakes of milk is unacquainted with the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. (Hebrews 5:13)
- You, therefore, beloved ones, having this advance knowledge, be on your guard that you may not be led away with them by the error of the law-defying people and fall from your own steadfastness. (2 Peter 3:17)
- These are the rocks hidden below water in Your love feasts while they feast with You, shepherds that feed themselves without fear, waterless clouds carried this way and that by winds, trees in late autumn, but fruitless, having died twice, having been uprooted. (Jude 1:12)
- After this I saw four angels standing upon the four corners of the earth, holding tight the four winds of the earth, that no wind might blow upon the earth or upon the sea or upon any tree. (Revelation 7:1)
