You no longer go on walking just as the nations also walk in the unprofitableness of their minds.

- For the time that has passed by is sufficient for you to have worked out the will of the nations when you proceeded in deeds of loose conduct, lusts, excesses with wine, revelries, drinking matches, and illegal idolatries. (1 Peter 4:3)
- Because, although they knew God, they did not glorify him as God nor did they thank him, but they became empty-headed in their reasonings and their unintelligent heart became darkened. (Romans 1:21)
- Watch out for yourself for fear you may be entrapped after them, after they have been annihilated from before you, and for fear you may inquire respecting their gods, saying, How was it these nations used to serve their gods? And I, yes, I, will do the same way. (Deuteronomy 12:30)
- I will rise and journey to my father and say to him; Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. (Luke 15:18)
- In which you at one time walked according to the system of things of this world, according to the ruler of the authority of the air, the spirit that now operates in the sons of disobedience. (Ephesians 2:2)
- Not in covetous sexual appetite such as also those nations have which do not know God. (1 Thessalonians 4:5)
