Ephesians 4:2" With complete lowliness of mind and mildness, with long-suffering, putting up with one another in love.

[12] - References:

- Take my yoke upon You and learn from me, for I am mildtempered and lowly in heart, and You will find refreshment for YOUR souls. (Matthew 11:29)
- Slaving for the Lord with the greatest lowliness of mind and tears and trials that befell me by the plots of the Jews. (Acts of Apostles 20:19)
- For through the undeserved kindness given to me I tell everyone there among you not to think more of himself than it is necessary to think, but to think so as to have a sound mind, each one as God has distributed to him a measure of faith. (Romans 12:3)
- Doing nothing out of contentiousness or out of egotism, but with lowliness of mind considering that the others are superior to YOU. (Philippians 2:3)
- In like manner, you younger men, be in subjection to the older men. But all of you gird yourselves with lowliness of mind toward one another, because God opposes the haughty ones, but he gives undeserved kindness to the humble ones. (1 Peter 5:5)
- By purity, by knowledge, by long-suffering, by kindness, by Holy Spirit, by love free from hypocrisy. (2 Corinthians 6:6)
- On the other hand, we exhort YOU, brothers, admonish the disorderly, speak consolingly to the depressed souls, support the weak, be long-suffering toward all. (1 Thessalonians 5:14)
- Love is long-suffering and kind. Love is not jealous, it does not brag, does not get puffed up. (1 Corinthians 13:4)
- Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted. (Matthew 23:12)
- Be minded the same way toward others as to yourselves, do not be minding lofty things, but be led along with the lowly things.
 Do not become discreet in your own eyes. (Romans 12:16)

- Accordingly, as God's chosen ones, holy and loved, clothe yourselves with the tender affections of compassion, kindness, lowliness of mind, mildness, and long-suffering. (Colossians 3:12)
- To speak injuriously of no one, not to be belligerent, to be reasonable, exhibiting all mildness toward all men. (Titus 3:2)
