

**Ephesians 4:2** With complete lowliness of mind and mildness, with long-suffering, putting up with one another in love.

[12] - References:

- Take my yoke upon **YOU** and learn from me, for I am mild-tempered and lowly in heart, and **YOU** will find refreshment for **YOUR** souls. (**Matthew 11:29**)
- Slaving for the Lord with the greatest **lowliness** of **mind** and tears and trials that befell me by the plots of the Jews. (**Acts of Apostles 20:19**)
- For through the undeserved kindness given to me I tell everyone there among **YOU** not to think more of himself than it is necessary to think, but to think so as to have a sound **mind**, each one as God has distributed to him a measure of faith. (**Romans 12:3**)
- Doing nothing out of contentiousness or out of egotism, but with **lowliness** of **mind** considering that the others are superior to **YOU**. (**Philippians 2:3**)
- In like manner, **YOU** younger men, be in subjection to the older men. But all of **YOU** gird yourselves with **lowliness** of **mind** toward one another, because God opposes the haughty ones, but he gives undeserved kindness to the humble ones. (**1 Peter 5:5**)
- By purity, by knowledge, by **long-suffering**, by kindness, by Holy Spirit, by **love** free from hypocrisy. (**2 Corinthians 6:6**)
- On the other hand, we exhort **YOU**, brothers, admonish the disorderly, speak consolingly to the depressed souls, support the weak, be **long-suffering** toward all. (**1 Thessalonians 5:14**)
- Love is **long-suffering** and kind. Love is not jealous, it does not brag, does not get puffed up. (**1 Corinthians 13:4**)
- Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted. (**Matthew 23:12**)
- Be minded the same way toward others as to yourselves, do not be minding lofty things, but be led along with the lowly things. Do not become discreet in **YOUR** own eyes. (**Romans 12:16**)

- **Accordingly, as God's chosen ones, holy and loved, clothe yourselves with the tender affections of compassion, kindness, **lowliness of mind, mildness, and long-suffering.** (Colossians 3:12)**
- **To speak injuriously of no one, not to be belligerent, to be reasonable, exhibiting all **mildness** toward all men. (Titus 3:2)**
