

Ephesians 4:22 That **YOU** should put away the old personality which conforms to **YOUR** former course of conduct and which is being corrupted according to his deceptive desires.

[11] - References:

- Because we know that our **old personality** was impaled with him, that our sinful body might be made inactive, that we should no longer go on **being** slaves to sin. (**Romans 6:6**)
- Do not be lying to one another. Strip off the **old personality** with its practices. (**Colossians 3:9**)
- For if **you** live in accord with the flesh **you** are sure to die, but if **you** **put** the practices of the body to death by the spirit, **you** will live. (**Romans 8:13**)
- But I behold in my members another Law warring against the Law of my mind and leading me captive to sin's Law that is in my members. (**Romans 7:23**)
- Remove from yourself the crookedness of speech, and the deviousness of lips **put** far **away** from yourself. (**Proverbs 4:24**)
- Jesus said to him; He that has bathed does not need to have more than his feet washed, but is wholly clean. And **you** men are clean, but not all. (**John 13:10**)
- Repent, therefore, and turn around so as to get **YOUR** sins blotted out, that seasons of refreshing may come from the person of Yehowah (**Acts of Apostles 3:19**)
- Consequently if anyone is in union with Christ, he is a new creation, the **old** things passed **away**, look! New things have come into existence. (**2 Corinthians 5:17**)
- For this reason, now that we have left the primary doctrine about the Christ, let us press on to maturity, not laying a foundation again, namely, repentance from dead works, and faith toward God. (**Hebrews 6:1**)
- Accordingly, **put away** all badness and all deceitfulness and hypocrisy and envies and all sorts of backbiting. (**1 Peter 2:1**)

- **Yet these men are speaking abusively of all the things they really do not know, but all the things that they do understand naturally like the unreasoning animals, in these things they go on corrupting themselves. (Jude 1:10)**
