- But if **YOU** have bitter jealousy and contentiousness in **YOUR** hearts, do not be bragging and lying against the truth. (**James 3:14**)
- But now really put them all **away** from **YOU**, **wrath**, **anger**, **badness**, **abusive speech**, and obscene talk out of **YOUR** mouth. (**Colossians 3:8**)
- To speak injuriously of no one, not to be belligerent, to be reasonable, exhibiting all mildness toward all men. (**Titus 3:2**)
- Cursed be their **anger**, because it is cruel, and their fury, because it acts harshly. Let me parcel them out in Jacob and let me scatter them in Israel. (**Genesis 49:7**)
- Then Saul's **anger** grew hot against Jonathan and he said to him; You son of a rebellious maid, do I not well know that you are choosing the son of Jesse to your own shame and to the shame of the secret parts of your mother? (**1 Samuel 20:30**)
- And the king began to answer them harshly. Thus King Rehoboam left the counsel of the older men. (**2 Chronicles 10:13**)
- Filled as they were with all unrighteousness, wickedness, covetousness, **badness**, being full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, **malicious** disposition, being whisperers. (**Romans 1:29**)
- **You** husbands, keep on loving your wives and do not be bitterly angry with them. (**Colossians 3:19**)
- He that says he is in the light and yet hates his brother is in the darkness up to right now. (**1 John 2:9**)
- Everyone who hates his brother is a manslayer, and **YOU** know that no manslayer has everlasting life remaining in him. (**1 John 3:15**)
