Figure 1:32. But become kind to one another, tenderly compassionate, freely forgiving one another just as God also by Christ freely forgave YOU.

- He has told you, O earthling man, what is good. And what is Yehowah asking back from you but to exercise justice and to love kindness and to be modest in walking with your God? (Micah 6:8)
- By purity, by knowledge, by long-suffering, by kindness, by Holy Spirit, by love free from hypocrisy. (2 Corinthians 6:6)
- Accordingly, as God's chosen ones, holy and loved, clothe yourselves with the tender affections of compassion, kindness, lowliness of mind, mildness, and long-suffering. (Colossians 3:12)
- Finally, all of You be like-minded, showing fellow feeling, having brotherly affection, tenderly compassionate, humble in mind. (1 Peter 3:8)
- For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. (Matthew 6:14)
- In like manner my heavenly Father will also deal with you if you do not forgive each one his brother from your hearts. (Matthew 18:35)
- And when you stand praying, forgive whatever you have against anyone, in order that your Father who is in the heavens may also forgive you your trespasses. (Mark 11:25)
- Anything you kindly forgive anyone, I do too. In fact, as for me, whatever I have kindly forgiven, if I have kindly forgiven anything, it has been for your sakes in Christ's sight. (2 Corinthians 2:10)
- This is what you are to say to Joseph; I beseech you, pardon, please, the revolt of your brothers and their sin in that they have rendered evil to you. And now pardon, please, the revolt of the servants of your father's God. And Joseph burst into tears when they spoke to him. (Genesis 50:17)

- Preserving loving-kindness for thousands, pardoning error and transgression and sin, but by no means will he give exemption from punishment, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon sons and upon grandsons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation. (Exodus 34:7)
- He has flashed up in the darkness as a light to the upright ones. He is gracious and merciful and righteous. (Psalms 112:4)
- The insight of a man certainly slows down his anger, and it is beauty on his part to pass over transgression. (Proverbs 19:11)
- It is a glory for a man to desist from disputing, but everyone foolish will burst out in it. (Proverbs 20:3)
- Jesus said to him; I say to you, not, Up to seven times, but, Up to seventy-seven times. (Matthew 18:22)
- He said; The one that acted mercifully toward him. Jesus then said to him; Go your way and be doing the same yourself. (Luke 10:37)
- And forgive us our sins, for we ourselves also forgive everyone that is in debt to us, and do not bring us into temptation. (Luke 11:4)
- Or he that exhorts, let him be at his exhortation, he that distributes, let him do it with liberality, he that presides, let him do it in real earnest, he that shows mercy, let him do it with cheerfulness. (Romans 12:8)
- Love is long-suffering and kind. Love is not jealous, it does not brag, does not get puffed up. (1 Corinthians 13:4)
- Does not behave indecently, does not look for its own interests, does not become provoked. It does not keep account of the injury. (1 Corinthians 13:5)
- Continue putting up with one another and forgiving one another freely if anyone has a cause for complaint against another. Even as Yehowah freely forgave YOU, so do YOU also. (Colossians 3:13)
- However, when the kindness and the love for man on the part of our Savior, God, was manifested. (Titus 3:4)
