[5] - References:

- You have **ascended on high**; You have **carried away captives**; You have taken **gifts** in the form of men, yes, even the stubborn ones, to reside among them, O Yah God. (**Psalms 68:18**)
- And God has set the respective ones in the congregation, first, apostles, second, prophets, third, teachers, then powerful works, then **gifts** of healings, helpful services, abilities to direct, different tongues. (**1 Corinthians 12:28**)
- And he **gave** some as apostles, some as prophets, some as evangelizers, some as shepherds and teachers. (**Ephesians 4:11**)
- And when the living creatures went, the wheels would go beside them, and when the living creatures were lifted up from the earth, the wheels would be lifted up. (**Ezekiel 1:19**)
