

Ephesians 5:11 And quit sharing with them in the unfruitful works that belong to the darkness, but, rather, even be reprovng them.

[14] - References:

- The night is well along, the day has drawn near. Let us therefore put off the **works** belonging to **darkness** and let us put on the weapons of the light. (**Romans 13:12**)
- He that is **reprovng** a man will afterward find more favor than he will that is flattering with his tongue. (**Proverbs 28:23**)
- Reprove before all onlookers persons who practice sin, that the rest also may have fear. (**1 Timothy 5:20**)
- Holding firmly to the faithful word as respects his art of teaching, that he may be able both to exhort by the teaching that is healthful and to reprove those who contradict. (**Titus 1:9**)
- This witness is true. For this very cause keep on **reprovng** them with severity, that they may be healthy in the faith. (**Titus 1:13**)
- All those for whom I have affection I reprove and discipline. Therefore be zealous and repent. (**Revelation 3:19**)
- Thus all the men of Israel were gathered against the city as one man, as allies. (**Judges 20:11**)
- Accordingly the tribes of Israel sent men to all the tribesmen of Benjamin, saying; What is this bad thing that has been brought about among **you**? (**Judges 20:12**)
- For that is the way he commanded me by the word of Yehowah, saying, You must not eat bread or drink water, and you must not return by the way that you went. (**1 Kings 13:9**)
- And Ahab the king of Israel went on to say to Jehoshaphat the king of Judah; Will you go with me to Ramoth-gilead? At this he said to him; I am the same as you are, and my people are like your people and with you in the war. (**2 Chronicles 18:3**)
- Shun it, do not pass along by it, turn aside from it, and pass along. (**Proverbs 4:15**)
- In the twilight, in the evening of the day, at the approach of the night and the gloom. (**Proverbs 7:9**)
