

Ephesians 5:26 That he might sanctify it, cleansing it with the bath of water by means of the word.

[14] - References:

- Hence Jesus also, that he might **sanctify** the people with his own blood, suffered outside the gate. (**Hebrews 13:12**)
- Sanctify them by **means** of the truth, your **word** is truth. (**John 17:17**)
- And Aaron and his sons must wash their hands and their feet at it. (**Exodus 30:19**)
- Then you must bring Aaron and his sons near to the entrance of the tent of meeting and wash them with **water**. (**Exodus 40:12**)
- So Moses brought Aaron and his sons near and washed them with **water**. (**Leviticus 8:6**)
- For on this day atonement will be made for **YOU** to pronounce **YOU** clean. **YOU** will be clean from all **YOUR** sins before Yehowah. (**Leviticus 16:30**)
- And as regards your birth, on the day of your being born your navel string had not been cut, and in **water** you had not been washed for **cleansing**, and with salt you had not at all been rubbed, and by no **means** had you been swaddled. (**Ezekiel 16:4**)
- Son of man, say to her, You are a land not being cleansed, one not rained down upon in the day of denunciation. (**Ezekiel 22:24**)
- There were four tables over here and four tables over there at the side of the gate, eight tables, upon which they would do the slaughtering. (**Ezekiel 40:41**)
- Peter said to him; You will certainly never wash my feet. Jesus answered him; Unless I wash you, you have no part with me. (**John 13:8**)
- Every branch in me not bearing fruit he takes away, and every one bearing fruit he cleans, that it may bear more fruit. (**John 15:2**)
- And yet that is what some of **YOU** were. But **YOU** have been washed clean, but **YOU** have been sanctified, but **YOU** have been

declared righteous in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ and with the spirit of our God. (1 Corinthians 6:11)

- **For this is what God wills, the sanctifying of you, that you abstain from fornication. (1 Thessalonians 4:3)**
- **Let us approach with true hearts in the full assurance of faith, having had our hearts sprinkled from a wicked conscience and our bodies bathed with clean water. (Hebrews 10:22)**
