Ephesians 5:27" That he might present the congregation to himself in its splendor, not having a spot or a wrinkle or any of such things, but that it should be holy and without blemish.

- Who gave himself for us that he might deliver us from every sort of lawlessness and cleanse for himself a people peculiarly his own, zealous for fine works. (Titus 2:14)

- Just as he chose us in union with him before the founding of the world, that we should be holy and without blemish before him in love. (Ephesians 1:4)

- Let us approach with true hearts in the full assurance of faith, having had our hearts sprinkled from a wicked conscience and our bodies bathed with clean water. (Hebrews 10:22)
- But anything not sacred and anyone that carries on a disgusting thing and a lie will in no way enter into it, only those written in the Lamb's scroll of life will. (Revelation 21:27)
- Speak to Aaron, saying; No man of your seed throughout their generations in whom there proves to be a defect may come near to present the bread of his God. (Leviticus 21:17)
- If you do not know for yourself, O you most beautiful one among women, go out yourself in the footprints of the flock and pasture your kids of the goats alongside the tabernacles of the shepherds. (Song of Solomon 1:8)
- I am asleep, but my heart is awake. There is the sound of my dear one knocking! Open to me, O my sister, my girl companion, my dove, my blameless one! For my head is filled with dew, the

locks of my hair with the drops of the night. (Song of Solomon 5:2)

- And it must occur that when they come into the gates of the inner courtyard, linen garments they should wear, and no wool should come up on them when they minister in the gates of the inner courtyard and inside. (Ezekiel 44:17)
- And when the people of the land come in before Yehowah in the festal seasons, the one coming in by the way of the north gate in order to bow down should go out by the way of the south gate, and the one coming in by the way of the south gate should go out by the way of the gate to the north. No one should go back by the way of the gate by which he came in, for he should go out straight ahead of him. (Ezekiel 46:9)
- That you may come to be blameless and innocent, children of God without a blemish in among a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you are shining as illuminators in the world.

 (Philippians 2:15)
- For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, a man, Christ Jesus. (1 Timothy 2:5)
- Now to the one who is able to guard you from stumbling and to set you unblemished in the sight of his glory with great joy. (Jude 1:24)
- And no falsehood was found in their mouths, they are without blemish. (Revelation 14:5)
- Yes, it has been granted to her to be arrayed in bright, clean, fine linen, for the fine linen stands for the righteous acts of the holy ones. (Revelation 19:8)
