- Observe, O my son, the commandment of your father, and do not forsake the Law of your mother. (Proverbs 6:20)
- Listen to your father who caused your birth, and do not despise your mother just because she has grown old. (Proverbs 23:22)
- You children, be obedient to your parents in everything, for this is well-pleasing in the Lord. (Colossians 3:20)
- In order that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in union with me and I am in union with you, that they also may be in union with us, in order that the world may believe that you sent me forth. (John 17:21)
- For the eyes of Yehowah are upon the righteous ones, and his ears are toward their supplication, but the face of Yehowah is against those doing bad things. (1 Peter 3:12)
- And now, my son, listen to my voice in what I am commanding you. (Genesis 27:8)
- And his sons proceeded to do for him exactly as he had commanded them. (Genesis 50:12)

- Listen, O sons, to the discipline of a father and pay attention, so as to know understanding. (Proverbs 4:1)
