Ephesians 6:2. Honor your father and your mother, which is the first command with a promise.

[13] - References:

- Listen to your father who caused your birth, and do not despise your mother just because she has grown old. (Proverbs 23:22)
- For example, God said: Honor your father and your mother, and, Let him that reviles father or mother end up in death. (Matthew 15:4)
- Honor your father and your mother in order that your days may prove long upon the ground that Yehowah your God is giving you. (Exodus 20:12)
- As for anyone calling down evil upon his father and his mother, his lamp will be extinguished at the approach of darkness. (Proverbs 20:20)
- Then she said to her father; Do not let anger gleam in the eyes of my lord, because I am not able to get up before you, for the customary thing with women is upon me. So he searched on carefully, but did not find the teraphim. (Genesis 31:35)
- You should fear each one his mother and his father, and my Sabbaths you should keep. I am Yehowah your God. (Leviticus 19:3)
- And YOU must preserve alive my father and my mother and my brothers and my sisters and all who belong to them, and YOU must deliver our souls from death. (Joshua 2:13)
- A son, for his part, honors a father, and a servant, his grand master. So if I am a father, where is the honor to me? And if I am a grand master, where is the fear of me? Yehowah of armies has said to YOU, O priests who are despising my name. And YOU have said; In what way have we despised your name? (Malachi 1:6)
- For example, Moses said: Honor your father and your mother.
 And: Let him that reviles father or mother end up in death.
 (Mark 7:10)

- You know the commandments. Do not murder. Do not commit adultery. Do not steal. Do not bear false witness. Do not defraud, Honor your father and mother. (Mark 10:19)
- You know the commandments, Do not commit adultery. Do not murder. Do not steal. Do not bear false witness. Honor your father and mother. (Luke 18:20)
- But if any widow has children or grandchildren, let these learn first to practice godly devotion in their own household and to keep paying a due compensation to their parents and grandparents, for this is acceptable in God's sight. (1 Timothy 5:4)
- For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, selfassuming, haughty, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, disloyal. (2 Timothy 3:2)
