- But I have sent **Tychicus** off to Ephesus. (**2 Timothy 4:12**)
- When I send Artemas or **Tychicus** to you, do your utmost to come to me at Nicopolis, for there is where I have decided to winter. (**Titus 3:12**)
- All my **affairs Tychicus**, my **beloved brother** and **faithful minister** and fellow slave in the **Lord**, will make known to **you**. (**Colossians 4:7**)
- There were accompanying him Sopater the son of Pyrrhus of Beroea, Aristarchus and Secundus of the Thessalonians, and Gaius of Derbe, and Timothy, and from the district of Asia **Tychicus** and Trophimus. (**Acts of Apostles 20:4**)
- Greet Herodion my relative. Greet those from the household of Narcissus who are in the **Lord**. (**Romans 16:11**)
- That is why, if I come, I **will** call to remembrance his works which he goes on **doing**, chattering **about** us with wicked words. Also, not being content with these things, neither does he himself receive the **brothers** with respect, and those who are wanting to receive them he tries to hinder and to throw out of the congregation. (**3 John 1:10**)
