In order to walk worthily of Yehowah to the end of fully pleasing him as you go on bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the accurate knowledge of God.

[19] - References

- I, therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, entreat you to walk worthily of the calling with which you were called. (Ephesians 4:1)
- For all the peoples, for their part, will walk each one in the name of its god, but we, for our part, shall walk in the name of Yehowah our God to time indefinite, even forever. (Micah 4:5)
- For we are a product of his work and were created in union with Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared in advance for us to walk in them. (Ephesians 2:10)
- That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the accurate knowledge of him. (Ephesians 1:17)
- However, there also came to be false prophets among the people, as there will also be false teachers among you. These very ones will quietly bring in destructive sects and will disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (2 Peter 2:1)
- For that righteous man by what he saw and heard while dwelling among them from day to day was tormenting his righteous soul by reason of their Lawless deeds. (2 Peter 2:8)
- And Enoch kept walking with the true God. Then he was no more, for God took him. (Genesis 5:24)

- And now make confession to Yehowah the God of YOUR forefathers and do his pleasure and separate yourselves from the peoples of the land and from the foreign wives. (Ezra 10:11)
- And on the second day the heads of the fathers of all the people, the priests and the Levites, gathered themselves together to Ezra the copyist, even to gain insight into the words of the Law. (Nehemiah 8:13)
- When Yehowah takes pleasure in the ways of a man he causes even his enemies themselves to be at peace with him. (Proverbs 16:7)
- Finally, the ones that were sown on the fine soil are those who listen to the word and favorably receive it and bear fruit thirtyfold and sixty and a hundred. (Mark 4:20)
- So, my brothers, YOU also were made dead to the Law through the body of the Christ, that YOU might become anothers, the one's who was raised up from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God. (Romans 7:4)
- On the other hand, the fruitage of the spirit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, faith. (Galatians 5:22)
- Only behave in a manner worthy of the Good News about the Christ, in order, that, whether I come and see you or be absent, I may hear about the things which concern you, that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one soul striving side by side for the faith of the Good News. (Philippians 1:27)
- To the end that you should go on walking worthily of God who is calling you to his kingdom and glory. (1 Thessalonians 2:12)
- Finally, brothers, we request you and exhort you by the Lord Jesus, just as you received the instruction from us on how you ought to walk and please God, just as you are in fact walking, that you would keep on doing it more fully. (1 Thessalonians 4:1)
- Continue reminding them to be in subjection and be obedient to governments and authorities as rulers, to be ready for every good work. (Titus 3:1)
- But let our people also learn to maintain fine works so as to meet their pressing needs, that they may not be unfruitful. (Titus 3:14)
- I know your deeds, and your love and faith and ministry and endurance, and that your deeds of late are more than those formerly. (Revelation 2:19)
