- But I say, Keep walking by spirit and you will carry out no fleshly desire at all. (Galatians 5:16)
- I, therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, entreat you to walk worthily of the calling with which you were called. (Ephesians 4:1)
- In order to walk worthily of Yehowah to the end of fully pleasing him as you go on bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the accurate knowledge of God. (Colossians 1:10)
- But, in accord with the Holy One who called You, do You also become holy yourselves in all Your conduct. (1 Peter 1:15)
- He who is calling you is faithful, and he will also do it. (1 Thessalonians 5:24)
- To that very end indeed we always pray for You, that our God may count You worthy of his calling and perform completely all he pleases of goodness and the work of faith with power. (2 Thessalonians 1:11)
- But, after you have suffered a little while, the God of all undeserved kindness, who called you to his everlasting glory in union with Christ, will himself finish your training, he will make you firm, he will make you strong. (1 Peter 5:10)
- And Enoch kept walking with the true God. Then he was no more, for God took him. (Genesis 5:24)
- Only be very careful to carry out the commandment and the Law that Moses the servant of Yehowah commanded you by loving Yehowah your God and by walking in all his ways and by keeping his

commandments and by cleaving to him and by serving him with all YOUR heart and with all YOUR soul. (Joshua 22:5)

- Then the king will say to those on his right; Come, you who have been blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the founding of the world. (Matthew 25:34)
- To all those who are in Rome as God's beloved ones, called to be holy ones; May you have undeserved kindness and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (Romans 1:7)
- Moreover, those whom he foreordained are the ones he also called, and those whom he called are the ones he also declared to be righteous. Finally those whom he declared righteous are the ones he also glorified. (Romans 8:30)
- But when God, who separated me from my mother's womb and called me through his undeserved kindness, thought good (Galatians 1:15)
- To this very destiny he called you through the Good News we declare, for the purpose of acquiring the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Thessalonians 2:14)
- Consequently, holy brothers, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the apostle and High Priest whom we confess, Jesus. (Hebrews 3:1)
