

## WANDER - FORTY YEARS FOR ERRORS

**Numbers 14:34**· By the number of the days that you spied out the land, forty days, a day for a year, a day for a year, you will answer for YOUR errors forty years, as you must know what my being estranged means.

- Finally at the end of **forty days** they returned from spying **out** the **land**. (**Numbers 13:25**)
- And you **must** complete them. And you **must** lie upon your right side in the second case, and you **must** carry the error of the house of Judah **forty days**. A **day** for a **year**, a **day** for a **year**, is **what** I have given you. (**Ezekiel 4:6**)
- For **forty years** I kept feeling a loathing toward that generation, and I proceeded to say; They are a people wayward at heart, and they themselves have not come to **know** my ways. (**Psalms 95:10**)
- This man led them **out** after doing portents and signs in Egypt and in the Red Sea and in the wilderness for **forty years**. (**Acts of Apostles 7:36**)
- And for a period of about **forty years** he put up with their manner of action in the wilderness. (**Acts of Apostles 13:18**)
- O God, you have cast us off, you have broken through us, you have become incensed. You should restore us. (**Psalms 60:1**)
- Is it not you, O God, who have cast us off and who do not go forth with our armies as God? (**Psalms 108:11**)
- All the while the **land** was left abandoned by them and was paying off its Sabbaths while it was lying desolated without them and they themselves were paying for their error, because, even because, they had rejected my judicial decisions, and their souls had abhorred my statutes. (**Leviticus 26:43**)

- And the people kept speaking against God and Moses; Why have **you** brought us up **out** of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no bread and no water, and our soul has come to abhor the contemptible bread. (**Numbers 21:5**)
- And they began to cry **out** to Yehowah. So he placed a darkness between **you** and the Egyptians and brought the sea upon them and covered them, and **your** eyes got to see **what** I did in Egypt, and **you** took up dwelling in the wilderness many **days**. (**Joshua 24:7**)
- And I myself **must** give to you the **years** of their error to the number of three hundred and ninety **days**, and you **must** carry the error of the house of Israel. (**Ezekiel 4:5**)
- And I myself brought **you** people up **out** of the **land** of Egypt, and I kept making **you** walk through the wilderness **forty years**, in order to take possession of the **land** of the Amorite. (**Amos 2:10**)
