Deuteronomy 7:4 For he will turn your son from following me, and they will certainly serve other gods, and Yehowah's anger will indeed blaze against **you**, and he will certainly annihilate you in a hurry.

- Then you **will** have to take some of their daughters for your **sons**, and their daughters **will** be certain to have immoral intercourse with their **gods** and make your **sons** have immoral intercourse with their **gods**. (Exodus 34:16)

- And it came about in the time of Solomon's growing old that his wives themselves had inclined his heart to follow other **gods**, and his heart did not prove to be complete with Yehowah his God like the heart of David his father. (1 Kings 11:4)

- For Yehowah your God in your midst is a God exacting exclusive devotion, for fear the **anger** of Yehowah your God may **blaze against** you and he must **annihilate** you from off the surface of the ground. (Deuteronomy 6:15)

- If, though, **you will** not drive the inhabitants of the land away from before **you**, then those whom **you** leave of them **will certainly** become as pricks in **your** eyes and as thorns in **your** sides, and they **will** indeed harass **you** on the land in which **you will** be dwelling. (Numbers 33:55)

- In order that they may not teach **you** to do according to all their detestable things, which they have done to their **gods**, and **you** may indeed sin **against** Yehowah **your** God. (Deuteronomy 20:18)

- Thus they abandoned Yehowah the God of their fathers who had brought them out of the land of Egypt and went **following** other **gods** from among the **gods** of the peoples who were all around them and

they began bowing down to them, so that they offended Yehowah.
(Judges 2:12)

- Everywhere that they went out, the hand of Yehowah proved to be **against** them for calamity, just as Yehowah had spoken and just as Yehowah had sworn to them, and they got to be in very sore straits.
(Judges 2:15)

- Finally **Yehowah's anger** blazed **against** Israel and he said; For the reason that this nation have overstepped my covenant that I commanded their forefathers and have not listened to my voice.
(Judges 2:20)

- And Solomon proceeded to form a marriage alliance with Pharaoh the king of Egypt and to take Pharaoh's daughter and bring her to the City of David, until he finished building his own house and the house of Yehowah and Jerusalem's wall all around. (1 Kings 3:1)

- And Yehowah came to be incensed at Solomon, because his heart had inclined away from Yehowah the God of Israel, the one appearing to him twice. (1 Kings 11:9)

- And **Yehowah's anger** became hot **against** Israel, so that he gave them into the hand of Hazael the king of Syria and into the hand of Ben-hadad the **son** of Hazael all their days. (2 Kings 13:3)
