WARNINGS - FALSE PROPHETS

- Yehowah … Warns … False Prophets Israel by his prophets and visionaries, turn back from your bad way and keep my commandments. (2 Kings 17:13) [36] References
- ^{2 Kings} 17:13... And Yehowah kept warning Israel and Judah by means of all his prophets and every visionary, saying; Turn back from Your bad ways and keep my commandments, my statutes, according to all the Law that I commanded Your forefathers and that I have sent to You by means of my servants the prophets;

[36] - References

- And it must occur that if you should at all forget Yehowah your God and you should actually walk after other gods and serve them and bow down to them, I do bear witness against you today that you people will absolutely perish. (Deuteronomy 8:19)
- He went on to say to them; Apply Your hearts to all the words that I am speaking in warning to You today, that You may command YOUR sons to take care to do all the words of this Law. (Deuteronomy 32:46)
- Hear, O my people, and I will bear witness against you, O Israel, if you will listen to me. (Psalms 81:8)
- Although you are committing fornication, O Israel, let not Judah become guilty, and do not you people come to Gilgal, neither go up to Beth-aven nor swear As Yehowah is alive! (Hosea 4:15)
- And Yehowah went on to say to me; Unfaithful Israel has proved her own soul to be more righteous than treacherously dealing Judah. (Jeremiah 3:11)
- And he kept sending prophets among them to bring them back to Yehowah, and they kept bearing witness against them, but they did not give ear. (2 Chronicles 24:19)
- But they were continually making jest at the messengers of the true God and despising his words and mocking at his prophets, until the rage of Yehowah came up against his people, until there was no healing. (2 Chronicles 36:16)

- God, who long ago spoke on many occasions and in many ways to our forefathers by means of the prophets. (Hebrews 1:1)
- In former times in Israel this was the way the man would have talked on his going to seek God; Come, and let us go to the seer. For the prophet of today used to be called a seer in former times. (1 Samuel 9:9)
- As for the affairs of David the king, the first ones and the last, there they are written among the words of Samuel the seer and among the words of Nathan the prophet and among the words of Gad the visionary. (1 Chronicles 29:29)
- Let the wicked man leave his way, and the harmful man his thoughts, and let him return to Yehowah, who will have mercy upon him, and to our God, for he will forgive in a large way. (Isaiah 55:7)
- And now say, please, to the men of Judah and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, This is what Yehowah has said; Here I am forming against you a calamity and thinking against you a thought. Turn back, please, each one from his bad way, and make your ways and your dealings good. (Jeremiah 18:11)
- And Yehowah sent to you all his servants the prophets, rising up early and sending them, but you did not listen, neither did you incline your ear to listen. (Jeremiah 25:4)
- Throw off from yourselves all your transgressions in which you have transgressed and make for yourselves a new heart and a new spirit, for why should you die, O house of Israel? (Ezekiel 18:31)
- Finally he took the book of the covenant and read it in the ears of the people. Then they said; All that Yehowah has spoken we are willing to do and be obedient. (Exodus 24:7)
- Now these are the commandment, the regulations and the judicial decisions that Yehowah your God has commanded to teach you, so as to do them in the land to which you are passing over there to take possession of it. (Deuteronomy 6:1)
- Watch out for yourself that you may not forget Yehowah your God so as not to keep his commandments and his judicial decisions and his statutes that I am commanding you today. (Deuteronomy 8:11)
- And God proceeded to speak all these words, saying; (Exodus 20:1)

- And these are the judicial decisions that you are to set before them. (Exodus 21:1)
- And Moses proceeded to call all Israel and to say to them; Hear, O Israel, the regulations and the judicial decisions that I am speaking in YOUR ears today, and YOU must learn them and be careful to do them. (Deuteronomy 5:1)
- From the day that YOUR forefathers came forth out of the land of Egypt until this day, and I kept sending to YOU all my servants the prophets, daily getting up early and sending them. (Jeremiah 7:25)
- Down to this day they are doing according to their former religions. There were none fearing Yehowah and none doing according to his statutes and his judicial decisions and the Law and the commandment that Yehowah had commanded the sons of Jacob, whose name he made Israel. (2 Kings 17:34)
- And he kept sticking to Yehowah. He did not turn aside from following him, but he continued keeping his commandments that Yehowah had commanded Moses. (2 Kings 18:6)
- And the king kept standing by the pillar and now concluded the covenant before Yehowah, to walk after Yehowah and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all the heart and with all the soul by carrying out the words of this covenant that were written in this book. Accordingly all the people took their stand in the covenant. (2 Kings 23:3)
- Although you would bear witness against them to bring them back to your Law, they themselves even acted presumptuously and did not listen to your commandments, and against your own judicial decisions they sinned, which, if a man will do, he must also live by means of them. And they kept giving a stubborn shoulder, and their neck they hardened, and they did not listen. (Nehemiah 9:29)
- But you were indulgent with them for many years and kept bearing witness against them by your spirit by means of your prophets, and they did not give ear. Finally you gave them into the hand of the peoples of the lands. (Nehemiah 9:30)
- As for our kings, our princes, our priests and our forefathers, they have not performed your Law, nor paid attention to your commandments or to your testimonies with which you bore witness against them. (Nehemiah 9:34)

- And after her doing all these things I kept saying that she should return even to me, but she did not return, and Judah kept looking at her own treacherous sister. (Jeremiah 3:7)
- They saying; Turn back, please, every one from his bad way and from the badness of Your dealings, and continue dwelling upon the ground that Yehowah gave to You and to Your forefathers from long ago and to a long time to come. (Jeremiah 25:5)
- By listening to the words of my servants the prophets, whom I am sending to you, even rising up early and sending them, whom you have not listened to. (Jeremiah 26:5)
- But as for you, in case you have warned someone wicked and he does not actually turn back from his wickedness and from his wicked way, he himself for his error will die, but as for you, you will have delivered your own soul. (Ezekiel 3:19)
- And we have not obeyed the voice of Yehowah our God by walking in his Laws that he set before us by the hand of his servants the prophets. (Daniel 9:10)
- Whichever way they go, I shall spread out over them my net. Like flying creatures of the heavens I shall bring them down. I shall discipline them in agreement with the report to their assembly. (Hosea 7:12)
- He will not return to the land of Egypt, but Assyria will be his king, because they refused to return. (Hosea 11:5)
- And I spoke to the prophets, and visions I myself multiplied, and by the hand of the prophets I kept making likenesses. (Hosea 12:10)
- The words of Amos, who happened to be among the sheep raisers from Tekoa, which he visioned concerning Israel in the days of Uzziah the king of Judah and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash, the king of Israel, two years before the earthquake. (Amos 1:1)
