## WARNINGS - TURN BACK FOR WORSHIPPING FALSE GODS

Yehowah … Warns … Turning Back To False gods - If you turn back and actually leave my statutes and commandments and serve other gods and bow down to them. (2 Chronicles 7:19) [12] - References

But if you yourselves turn back and actually leave my statutes and my commandments that I have put before you, and you actually go and serve other gods and bow down to them,

- But my righteous one will live by reason of faith, and, if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him. (Hebrews 10:38)
- And if you will reject my statutes, and if your souls will abhor my judicial decisions so as not to do all my commandments, to the extent of your violating my covenant. (Leviticus 26:15)
- For, look! The very ones keeping away from you will perish. You will certainly silence every one immorally leaving you. (Psalms 73:27)
- And it must occur that if you will not listen to the voice of Yehowah your God by taking care to do all his commandments and his statutes that I am commanding you today, all these maledictions must also come upon you and overtake you. (Deuteronomy 28:15)
- Because of Your overstepping the covenant of Yehowah YOUR God that he commanded YOU, and because YOU have gone and served other gods and bowed down to them. And Yehowah's anger will certainly blaze against YOU, and YOU will certainly perish in a hurry from off the good land that he has given YOU. (Joshua 23:16)
- You must not bow down to them nor be induced to serve them, because I Yehowah your God am a God exacting exclusive devotion, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon sons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation, in the case of those who hate me. (Exodus 20:5)
- If you yourselves and your sons should definitely turn back from following me and not keep my commandments and my statutes that I have put before you men, and you actually go and serve other gods and bow down to them. (1 Kings 9:6)

- And respecting this thing he commanded him not to go after other gods, but he had not kept that which Yehowah had commanded. (1 Kings 11:10)
- And it came about in the fifth year of King Rehoboam that Shishak the king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem, for they had behaved unfaithfully toward Yehowah. (2 Chronicles 12:2)
- And I will speak with them my judgments over all their badness, in that they have left me and they keep making sacrificial smoke to other gods and bowing down to the works of their own hands. (Jeremiah 1:16)
- Is not this what you proceeded to do to yourself by your leaving Yehowah your God during the time of his walking you in the way? (Jeremiah 2:17)
- This bad people who are refusing to obey my words, who are walking in the stubbornness of their heart and who keep walking after other gods in order to serve them and to bow down to them, will also become just like this belt that is fit for nothing. (Jeremiah 13:10)
