John 14:6.. **Jesus said to him; I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.**

- **I am** the door, whoever enters **through** me will be saved, and he will go in and out and find pasturage. (**John 10:9**)
- Through whom also we have gained our approach by faith into this undeserved kindness in which we now stand, and let us exult, based on hope of the glory of God. (**Romans 5:2**)
- Because **through** him we, both peoples, have the approach to the **Father** by one spirit. (**Ephesians 2:18**)
- Which he inaugurated for us as a new and living **way through** the curtain, that is, his flesh. (**Hebrews 10:20**)
- Because the Law was given **through** Moses, the undeserved kindness and the **truth** came to be **through** Jesus Christ. (**John 1:17**)
- For I say that Christ actually became a minister of those who are circumcised in behalf of God's truthfulness, so as to verify the promises He made to their forefathers. (**Romans 15:8**)
- Provided, indeed, that **you** heard him and were taught by means of him, just as **truth** is in Jesus. (**Ephesians 4:21**)
- For those things are a shadow of the things to come, but the reality belongs to the Christ. (**Colossians 2:17**)
- By means of him was **life**, and the **life** was the light of men. (**John 1:4**)
- It is the spirit that is life-giving, the flesh is of no use at all. The sayings that I have spoken to **you** are spirit and are **life**. (**John 6:63**)

- This means everlasting **life**, their taking in knowledge of you, the only true God, and of the one whom you sent forth, Jesus Christ. (**John 17:3**)
- For the wages sin pays is death, but the gift God gives is everlasting **life** by Christ Jesus our Lord. (**Romans 6:23**)
- Do not be afraid of the things you are about to suffer. Look! The Devil will keep on throwing some of **you** into prison that **you** may be fully put to the test, and that **you** may have tribulation ten days. Prove yourself faithful even to death, and I will give you the crown of **life**. (**Revelation 2:10**)
- Furthermore, there is no salvation in anyone else, for there is not another name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must get saved. (**Acts of Apostles 4:12**)
- And the entrance of the innermost room he made with doors of oil-tree wood; side pillars, doorposts and a fifth. (**1 Kings 6:31**)
- Kiss the son, that He may not become incensed and **you** may not perish from the **way**, for his anger flares up easily. Happy are all those taking refuge in him. (**Psalms 2:12**)
- For the one finding me will certainly find **life**, and gets goodwill from Yehowah. (**Proverbs 8:35**)
- And he must become as a sacred place, but as a stone to strike against and as a rock over which to stumble to both the houses of Israel, as a trap and as a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. (**Isaiah 8:14**)
- And as a grain offering you should provide with it morning by morning the sixth of an ephah and, as regards oil, the third of a hin for sprinkling the fine flour. The grain offering to Yehowah is an indefinitely lasting statute, constantly. (**Ezekiel 46:14**)
- Therefore Jesus **said** again; Most truly I say to **you**, I **am** the door of the sheep. (**John 10:7**)
- Jesus **said** to her; I **am** the resurrection and the **life**. He that exercises faith in me, even though he dies, will come to **life**. (**John 11:25**)
- Therefore Pilate **said** to him; Well, then, are you a king? Jesus answered; You yourself are saying that I **am** a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, that I should bear

witness to the **truth**. Everyone that is on the side of the **truth** listens to my voice. (**John 18:37**)

- By means of whom we have this freeness of speech and an approach with confidence **through** our faith in him. (**Ephesians 3:12**)

- For the Law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in besides of a better hope did, **through** which we are drawing near to God. (**Hebrews 7:19**)

- Thus the Holy Spirit makes it plain that the **way** into the holy place had not yet been made manifest while the first tent was standing. (**Hebrews 9:8**)

- Therefore, brothers, since we have boldness for the **way** of entry into the holy place by the blood of Jesus. (**Hebrews 10:19**)

- As we look intently at the Chief Agent and Perfecter of our faith, Jesus. For the joy that was set before him he endured a torture stake, despising shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. (**Hebrews 12:2**)

- Who **through** him are believers in God, the one who raised him up from the dead and gave him glory, so that **YOUR** faith and hope might be in God. (**1 Peter 1:21**)

- Everyone that pushes ahead and does not remain in the teaching of the Christ does not have God. He that does remain in this teaching is the one that has both the **Father** and the Son. (**2 John 1:9**)

- And the third angel blew his trumpet. And a great star burning as a lamp fell from heaven, and it fell upon a third of the rivers and upon the fountains of waters. (**Revelation 8:10**)

- And no falsehood was found in their mouths, they are without blemish. (**Revelation 14:5**)
