- For a fire **has** been ignited in my anger and it **will** burn down to Sheol, the lowest place, and it **will** consume the **earth** and its produce and **will** set ablaze the **foundations** of **mountains**. (**Deuteronomy 32:22**)
- The Divine One, God, **Yehowah**, **has** himself spoken, and he proceeds to call the **earth**, from the rising of the sun until its setting. (**Psalms 50:1**)
- When he set for the sea his decree that the waters themselves should not pass beyond his order, when he decreed the **foundations** of the **earth**. (**Proverbs 8:29**)
- Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O **earth**, for **Yehowah** himself **has** spoken; Sons I have brought up and raised, but they themselves have revolted against me. (**Isaiah 1:2**)
- This is what **Yehowah has** said; If the heavens up above could be measured and the **foundations** of the **earth** below could be searched out, I myself also could reject the entire seed of **Israel** on account of all that they have done, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 31:37**)
- Remind me, let us put ourselves on judgment together, tell your own account of it in order, that you may be in the right. (**Isaiah 43:26**)
- But you say, I have remained innocent. Surely his anger **has** turned back from me. Here I am entering into controversy with you on account of your saying; I have not sinned. (**Jeremiah 2:35**)

- Hear the word of **Yehowah**, O sons of **Israel**, for **Yehowah has a legal case** with the inhabitants of the land, for there is no truth nor loving-kindness nor knowledge of God in the land. (**Hosea 4:1**)
- He calls to the heavens above and to the **earth** so as to execute judgment on his **people**. (**Psalms 50:4**)
- Come, now, **you people**, and let us set matters straight between us, says **Yehowah**. Though the sins of **you people** should prove to be as scarlet, they **will** be made white just like snow, though they should be red like crimson cloth, they **will** become even like wool. (**Isaiah 1:18**)
- **Yehowah** is stationing himself to contend and is standing up to pass sentence upon **peoples**. (**Isaiah 3:13**)
- And now, O **you** inhabitants of Jerusalem and **you** men of Judah, please judgment between me and my vineyard. (**Isaiah 5:3**)
- Therefore I shall contend further with **you** people, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, and with the sons of **YOUR** sons I shall contend. (**Jeremiah 2:9**)
- A noise **will** certainly come clear to the farthest part of the **earth**, for there is a controversy that **Yehowah has** with the nations. He must personally put himself in judgment with all flesh. As regards the wicked ones, he must give them to the sword, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 25:31**)
- And you must say, O **mountains** of **Israel**, hear the word of the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**; This is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah has** said to the **mountains** and to the hills, to the streambeds and to the valleys; Here I am! I am bringing upon **you** a sword, and I shall certainly destroy **YOUR** high places. (**Ezekiel 6:3**)
- And I **will** spread over him my net, and he **will** certainly be caught in my hunting net, and I **will** bring him to Babylon and put myself on judgment with him there respecting his unfaithfulness with which he acted against me. (**Ezekiel 17:20**)
- And **Yehowah has a legal case** with Judah, even to hold an accounting against Jacob according to his ways, according to his dealings he **will** repay him. (**Hosea 12:2**)
