[17] - References

- For a fire has been ignited in my anger and it will burn down to Sheol, the lowest place, and it will consume the earth and its produce and will set ablaze the foundations of mountains. (Deuteronomy 32:22)
- The Divine One, God, Yehowah, has himself spoken, and he proceeds to call the earth, from the rising of the sun until its setting. (Psalms 50:1)
- When he set for the sea his decree that the waters themselves should not pass beyond his order, when he decreed the foundations of the earth. (Proverbs 8:29)
- Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth, for Yehowah himself has spoken; Sons I have brought up and raised, but they themselves have revolted against me. (Isaiah 1:2)
- This is what Yehowah has said; If the heavens up above could be measured and the foundations of the earth below could be searched out, I myself also could reject the entire seed of Israel on account of all that they have done, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 31:37)
- Remind me, let us put ourselves on judgment together, tell your own account of it in order, that you may be in the right. (Isaiah 43:26)
- But you say, I have remained innocent. Surely his anger has turned back from me. Here I am entering into controversy with you on account of your saying; I have not sinned. (Jeremiah 2:35)

- Hear the word of Yehowah, O sons of Israel, for Yehowah has a legal case with the inhabitants of the land, for there is no truth nor loving-kindness nor knowledge of God in the land. (Hosea 4:1)
- He calls to the heavens above and to the earth so as to execute judgment on his people. (Psalms 50:4)
- Come, now, you people, and let us set matters straight between us, says Yehowah. Though the sins of you people should prove to be as scarlet, they will be made white just like snow, though they should be red like crimson cloth, they will become even like wool. (Isaiah 1:18)
- Yehowah is stationing himself to contend and is standing up to pass sentence upon peoples. (Isaiah 3:13)
- And now, O you inhabitants of Jerusalem and you men of Judah, please judge between me and my vineyard. (Isaiah 5:3)

I am bringing upon you a sword, and I shall certainly destroy your high places. (Ezekiel 6:3)
