- But they were continually making jest at the messengers of the true God and despising his words and mocking at his prophets, until the rage of Yehowah came up against his people, until there was no healing. (**2 Chronicles 36:16**)
- And they should not become like their forefathers, a generation stubborn and rebellious, a generation who had not prepared their heart and whose spirit was not trustworthy with God. (**Psalms 78:8**)
- Listen to me, **you** the ones powerful at heart, **you** the ones far away from righteousness. (**Isaiah 46:12**)
- But they kept refusing to pay attention, and they kept giving a stubborn shoulder, and their ears they made too unresponsive to hear. (**Zechariah 7:11**)
- And Yehowah went on to say to Moses; I have looked at this people and here it is a stiff-necked people. (**Exodus 32:9**)
- And **you** must circumcise the foreskin of **your** hearts and not harden **your necks** any longer. (**Deuteronomy 10:16**)
- And they did not listen but kept hardening their **necks** like the **necks** of their forefathers that had not exercised faith in Yehowah their God. (**2 Kings 17:14**)
- As regards the word that you have spoken to us in the name of Yehowah, we are not listening to you. (**Jeremiah 44:16**)
- And you must know that it is not for your righteousness that Yehowah your God is giving you this good land to take possession of it, for you are a stiff-necked people. (**Deuteronomy 9:6**)

- For I, I well know your rebelliousness and your stiff neck. If while I am yet alive with you today, you have proved rebellious in behavior toward Yehowah, then how much more so after my death! (Deuteronomy 31:27)
- And it occurred that when the judge died they would turn around and act more ruinously than their fathers by walking after other gods to serve them and bow down to them. They did not refrain from their practices and their stubborn behavior. (Judges 2:19)
- All of them are the most stubborn men, walking about as slanderers, copper and iron. They are all of them ruinous. (Jeremiah 6:28)
- And I will give them one heart, and a new spirit I shall put inside them, and I shall certainly remove the heart of stone from their flesh and give them a heart of flesh. (Ezekiel 11:19)
