- O sword, awake against my shepherd, even against the able-bodied man who is my associate, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies. Strike the shepherd, and let those of the flock be scattered, and I shall certainly turn my hand back upon those who are insignificant. **(Zechariah 13:7)**
- And they all abandoned him and fled. **(Mark 14:50)**
- Look! The hour is coming, indeed, it has come, when **you** will be scattered each one to his own house and **you** will leave me alone, and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me. **(John 16:32)**
- They now **led Jesus away** to the **High Priest**, and all the chief **priests** and the **older men** and the **scribes** assembled. **(Mark 14:53)**
- And they **led** him first to Annas, for he was father-in-law to **Caiaphas**, who was **High Priest** that year. **(John 18:13)**
- Then they arrested him and **led** him off and brought him into the house of the **High Priest**, but Peter was following at a distance. **(Luke 22:54)**
- Then the chief **priests** and the **older men** of the people **gathered together** in the courtyard of the **High Priest** who was called **Caiaphas**. **(Matthew 26:3)**
- In the days of chief **priest** Annas and of **Caiaphas**, God's declaration came to John the son of Zechariah in the wilderness. **(Luke 3:2)**
- Then Annas sent him **away** bound to **Caiaphas** the **High Priest**. **(John 18:24)**

- Also Annas the chief **priest** and **Caiaphas** and John and Alexander and as many as were of the chief priest's kinsfolk. (**Acts of Apostles 4:6**)
