- For this is what Yehowah has said to the king sitting on the throne of David and to all the people dwelling in this city, your brothers that have not gone forth with you into exile. (Jeremiah 29:16)
- For there is a cup in the hand of Yehowah, and the wine is foaming, it is full of mixture. And he will surely pour out its dregs from it, all the wicked ones of the earth will drain them out, drink them. (Psalms 75:8)
- Linger, You men, and be amazed, blind yourselves, and be blinded. They have become intoxicated, but not with wine, they have moved unsteadily, but not because of intoxicating liquor. (Isaiah 29:9)
- Rouse yourself, rouse yourself, rise up, O Jerusalem, you who have drunk at the hand of Yehowah his cup of rage. The goblet, the cup causing reeling, you have drunk, you have drained out. (Isaiah 51:17)
- And I kept stamping down peoples in my anger, and I proceeded to make them drunk with my rage and to bring down to the earth their spurting blood. (Isaiah 63:6)
- And you must say to them; This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Drink and get drunk and puke and fall so that you cannot get up because of the sword that I am sending among you. (Jeremiah 25:27)

- Boy and old man have lain down on the earth of the streets. My virgins and my young men themselves have fallen by the sword. You have killed in the day of your anger. You have slaughtered, you have had no compassion. (Lamentations 2:21)
- And my eye will not feel sorry for you, neither will I feel compassion, for upon you I shall bring your own ways, and in the midst of you your own detestable things will come to be, and you people will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 7:4)
- Neither will my eye feel sorry nor shall I feel compassion. According to your ways shall I do the bringing upon you yourself, and your own detestable things will come to be right in the midst of you, and you people will have to know that I am Yehowah doing the smiting. (Ezekiel 7:9)
- I myself, Yehowah, have spoken. It must come, and I will act. I shall not neglect, neither shall I feel sorry nor feel regret. According to your ways and according to your dealings they will certainly judge you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 24:14)
