~ Men ··· Unrighteous ··· Wicked Caught In Net - Let ruin come to them without their knowing, let him be caught in his own net and fall to ruin (Psalms 35:8) [10] - References

Psalms 35:8... Let ruin come upon him without his knowing, and let his own net that he hid catch him, with ruin let him fall into it.
