## **WICKED - CHARGES INTEREST**

~ Men ··· Unrighteous ··· Charges Interest - He that grows his wealth by usury and interest collects the money for the one showing favor to the lowly ones (Proverbs 28:8) [12] - References

Proverbs 28:8" He that is multiplying his valuables by interest and usury collects them merely for the one showing favor to the lowly ones.

[12] - References

- Do not take interest and usury from him, but you must be in fear of your God, and your brother must keep alive with you. (Leviticus 25:36)
- You must not make your brother pay interest, interest on money, interest on food, interest on anything on which one may claim interest. (Deuteronomy 23:19)
- On usury he has given, and interest he has taken, and he positively will not keep living. All these detestable things he has done. He will positively be put to death. On him his own blood will come to be. (Ezekiel 18:13)
- He would prepare, but the righteous would be the one to clothe himself, and in the silver the innocent would be the one to have a share. (Job 27:17)
- One who is good will leave an inheritance to sons of sons, and the wealth of the sinner is something treasured up for the righteous one. (Proverbs 13:22)
- He that is showing favor to the lowly one is lending to Yehowah, and his treatment He will repay to him. (Proverbs 19:17)
- You may make a foreigner pay interest, but your brother you must not make pay interest, in order, that Yehowah your God may bless you in every undertaking of yours on the land to which you are going so as to take possession of it. (Deuteronomy 23:20)
