

WICKED - CONCEALED FROM YEHOWAH

Micah 3:4 At that time they will call to Yehowah for aid, but he will not answer them. And he will conceal his face from them in that time, according as they committed badness in their dealings.

- At that time they **will** keep calling me, but I shall not **answer**, they **will** keep looking for me, but they **will** not find me. (**Proverbs 1:28**)
- And when **YOU** spread out **YOUR** palms, I hide my eyes from **YOU**. Even though **YOU** make many prayers, I am not listening, with bloodshed **YOUR** very hands have become filled. (**Isaiah 1:15**)
- We know that God does not listen to sinners, but if anyone is God-fearing and does his **will**, he listens to this one. (**John 9:31**)
- At that my anger **will** indeed blaze against them in that day, and I shall certainly forsake them and **conceal** my **face** from them, and they must become something to be consumed, and many calamities and distresses must come upon them, and they **will** be bound to say in that day; Is it not because our God is not in our midst that these calamities have come upon us? (**Deuteronomy 31:17**)
- Concerning those who are coming to fight against the Chaldeans and to fill places with the carcasses of the men whom I have struck down in my anger and in my rage, and on account of all whose **badness** I have concealed my **face** from this city. (**Jeremiah 33:5**)
- You have blocked approach to yourself with a cloud mass, that prayer may not pass through. (**Lamentations 3:44**)
- Woe to the wicked one! Calamity, for the treatment rendered by his own hands **will** be rendered to him! (**Isaiah 3:11**)

- However, for those who are contentious and who disobey the truth but obey unrighteousness there **will** be wrath and anger. (**Romans 2:8**)
- Here you are actually driving me this day from off the surface of the ground, and from your **face** I shall be concealed, and I must become a wanderer and fugitive on the earth, and it is certain that anyone finding me **will** kill me. (**Genesis 4:14**)
- As for **you**, **you** abandoned me and took up serving other gods. That is why I shall not save **you** again. (**Judges 10:13**)
- And **you will** certainly cry out in that day by reason of **your** king, whom **you** have chosen for yourselves, but **Yehowah will** not **answer you** in that day. (**1 Samuel 8:18**)
- Although Saul would inquire of **Yehowah**, **Yehowah** never answered him, either by dreams or by the Urim or by the prophets. (**1 Samuel 28:6**)
- They cry for help, but there is no savior, to **Yehowah**, but he actually does not **answer** them. (**2 Samuel 22:42**)
- To this Elisha said; As **Yehowah** of armies before whom I do stand is living, if it were not that it is the **face** of Jehoshaphat the king of Judah for which I am having consideration, I would not look at you or see you. (**2 Kings 3:14**)
- They cry for help, but there is no savior, to **Yehowah**, but he actually does not **answer** them. (**Psalms 18:41**)
- When he is judged, let him go forth as someone wicked, and let his very prayer become a sin. (**Psalms 109:7**)
- Look! I and the children whom **Yehowah** has given me are as signs and as miracles in Israel from **Yehowah** of armies, who is residing in Mount Zion. (**Isaiah 8:18**)
- I myself shall tell forth your righteousness and your works, that they **will** not benefit you. (**Isaiah 57:12**)
- For what reason did we fast and you did not see, and did we afflict our soul and you would take no note? Indeed **you** people were finding delight in the very day of **your** fasting, when there were all **your** toilers that **you** kept driving to work. (**Isaiah 58:3**)
- No, but the very errors of **you** people have become the things causing division between **you** and **your** God, and **your** own sins have

caused the concealing of his **face** from **you** to keep from hearing.
(**Isaiah 59:2**)

- And as for you, do not pray in behalf of this people, neither raise in their behalf an entreating cry or a prayer nor beseech me, for I shall not be listening to you. (**Jeremiah 7:16**)

- Therefore this is what **Yehowah** has said; Here I am bringing upon them a calamity that they **will** not be able to get out of, and they **will** certainly **call** to me for **aid**, but I shall not listen to them. (**Jeremiah 11:11**)

- Also, when I **call** for **aid** and cry for help, he actually hampers my prayer. (**Lamentations 3:8**)

- And I myself also shall act in rage. My eye **will** not feel sorry, neither shall I feel compassion. And they **will** certainly **call** out in my ears with a loud voice, but I shall not hear them. (**Ezekiel 8:18**)

- With their flock and with their herd they proceeded to go and look for **Yehowah**, but they could not find him. He had drawn away from them. (**Hosea 5:6**)

- **You** do ask, and yet **you** do not receive, because **you** are asking for a wrong purpose, that **you** may expend it upon **YOUR** cravings for sensual pleasure. (**James 4:3**)
