

WICKED - CRITICIZE RIGHTEOUS ONES

~ **Men ... Unrighteous ... Criticize Righteous Ones** - The presiding officer of the synagogue told Jesus, there are six days on which work must be done, but there should be no curing of people on the Sabbath· (Luke 13:14) ^[11] - References

Luke 13:14· But in response the presiding officer of the synagogue, indignant because Jesus did the cure on the Sabbath, began to say to the crowd; There are six days on which work ought to be done, on them, therefore, come and be cured, and not on the Sabbath day.

^[11] - References

- You are to render service and you must do all your **work six days**. (Exodus 20:9)
- Six **days** you are to do your **work**, but on the seventh day you are to desist, in order, that your bull and your ass may rest and the son of your slave girl and the alien resident may refresh themselves. (Exodus 23:12)
- Six **days** may **work** be done, but on the seventh day it will become something holy to **you**, a **Sabbath** of complete rest to Yehowah. Anybody doing **work** on it will be put to death. (Exodus 35:2)
- But the seventh day is a **Sabbath** to Yehowah your God. You must not do any **work**, you nor your son nor your daughter nor your slave man nor your slave girl nor your bull nor your ass nor any domestic animal of yours nor your alien resident who is inside your gates, in order, that your slave man and your slave girl may rest the same as you. (Deuteronomy 5:14)
- And, look! A man with a withered hand! So they asked him; Is it Lawful to **cure** on the Sabbath? That they might get an accusation against him. (Matthew 12:10)
- So they were watching him closely to see whether he would **cure** the man on the **Sabbath**, in order, that they might accuse him. (Mark 3:2)
- So on this account the Jews went persecuting **Jesus**, because he was doing these things during Sabbath. (John 5:16)

- Six **days** you are to labor, but on the seventh day you will keep **Sabbath**. In plowing time and in harvest you will keep **Sabbath**. (**Exodus 34:21**)
- For the reason that with flank and with shoulder **YOU** kept pushing and with **YOUR** horns **YOU** kept shoving all the sickened ones until **YOU** had scattered them to the outside. (**Ezekiel 34:21**)
- In the course of another **Sabbath** he entered into the **synagogue** and **began** teaching. And there was a man present whose right hand was withered. (**Luke 6:6**)
- Incidentally it was Sabbath on the day that **Jesus** made the clay and opened his eyes. (**John 9:14**)
