Psalms 50:16 But to the wicked one God will have to say; What right do you have to enumerate my regulations, and that you may bear my covenant in your mouth?

• Hear this, O house of Jacob, **you** who are calling yourselves by the name of Israel and who **have** come forth from the very waters of Judah, **you** who are swearing by the name of Yehowah and who make mention even of the **God** of Israel, not in truth and not in righteousness. (**Isaiah 48:1**)

• And when someone wicked turns back from his wickedness that he has committed and proceeds to execute justice and righteousness, he is the one that **will** preserve his own soul alive. (**Ezekiel 18:27**)

• Do not put **YOUR** trust in fallacious words, saying; The temple of Yehowah, the temple of Yehowah, the temple of Yehowah they are! (**Jeremiah 7:4**)

• And yet then I **will** confess to them; I never knew **you**! Get away from me, **you** workers of Lawlessness. (**Matthew 7:23**)

• Do you, however, the one teaching someone else, not teach yourself? You, the one preaching; Do not steal! Do you steal? (**Romans 2:21**)

• So Yehowah **will have** to separate him for calamity from all the tribes of Israel in accord with all the oath of the **covenant** that is written in this book of the Law. (**Deuteronomy 29:21**)

• For I shall bring them to the ground that I **have** sworn about to their forefathers, which flows with milk and honey, and they **will** certainly eat and be satisfied and grow fat and turn to other gods, and they **will** indeed serve them and treat me with disrespect and break my **covenant**. (**Deuteronomy 31:20**)

- Not according to the **covenant** that I made with their forefathers in the day of my taking hold of their hand to bring them forth out of the land of Egypt, because they did not continue in my **covenant**, so that I stopped caring for them, **says** Yehowah. (**Hebrews 8:9**)
- And do not take away from my **mouth** the word of truth entirely, for I **have** waited for your own judicial decision. (**Psalms 119:43**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; No foreigner, uncircumcised in heart and uncircumcised in flesh, may come into my sanctuary, that is, any foreigner who is in the midst of the sons of Israel. (**Ezekiel 44:9**)
