## WICKED - DO NOT SPEAK FOR GOD

Men ··· Unrighteous ··· Wicked Not To Speak For God - What right do the wicked have to act as God's spokesperson, to bear his covenant in his mouth · (Psalms 50:16) [10] - References

Psalms 50:16. But to the wicked one God will have to say; What right do you have to enumerate my regulations, and that you may bear my covenant in your mouth?

[10] - References

- Hear this, O house of Jacob, YOU who are calling yourselves by the name of Israel and who have come forth from the very waters of Judah, YOU who are swearing by the name of Yehowah and who make mention even of the God of Israel, not in truth and not in righteousness. (Isaiah 48:1)
- And when someone wicked turns back from his wickedness that he has committed and proceeds to execute justice and righteousness, he is the one that will preserve his own soul alive. (Ezekiel 18:27)
- Do not put YOUR trust in fallacious words, saying; The temple of Yehowah, the temple of Yehowah, the temple of Yehowah they are! (Jeremiah 7:4)
- And yet then I will confess to them; I never knew You! Get away from me, You workers of Lawlessness. (Matthew 7:23)
- Do you, however, the one teaching someone else, not teach yourself? You, the one preaching; Do not steal! Do you steal? (Romans 2:21)
- So Yehowah will have to separate him for calamity from all the tribes of Israel in accord with all the oath of the covenant that is written in this book of the Law. (Deuteronomy 29:21)
- For I shall bring them to the ground that I have sworn about to their forefathers, which flows with milk and honey, and they will certainly eat and be satisfied and grow fat and turn to other gods, and they will indeed serve them and treat me with disrespect and break my covenant. (Deuteronomy 31:20)

- Not according to the covenant that I made with their forefathers in the day of my taking hold of their hand to bring them forth out of the land of Egypt, because they did not continue in my covenant, so that I stopped caring for them, says Yehowah. (Hebrews 8:9)
- And do not take away from my mouth the word of truth entirely, for I have waited for your own judicial decision. (Psalms 119:43)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; No foreigner, uncircumcised in heart and uncircumcised in flesh, may come into my sanctuary, that is, any foreigner who is in the midst of the sons of Israel. (Ezekiel 44:9)
