WICKED - EARNYEHOWAH'S DISFAVOR

Men … Unrighteous … Earn Yehowah's Disfavor - Here I am sending against them the sword, famine and pestilence and I will make them like the burst open figs that cannot be eaten for badness (Jeremiah 29:17) [10] - References

Jeremiah 29:17... This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Here I am sending against them the sword, the famine and the pestilence, and I will make them like the burst-open figs that cannot be eaten for badness.

- And You I shall scatter among the nations, and I will unsheathe a sword after You, and Your land must become a desolation, and Your cities will become a desolate ruin. (Leviticus 26:33)
- And I will send against them the sword, the famine and the pestilence, until they come to their finish off the ground that I gave to them and to their forefathers. (Jeremiah 24:10)
- Then you will have to eat the fruit of your belly, the flesh of your sons and your daughters, whom Yehowah your God has given you, because of the tightness and stress with which your enemy will hem you in. (Deuteronomy 28:53)
- And it must occur that should they say to you; Where shall we go out to? You must also say to them; This is what Yehowah has said; Whoever is for deadly plague, to deadly plague! And whoever is for the sword, to the sword! And whoever is for the famine, to the famine! And whoever is for the captivity, to the captivity! (Jeremiah 15:2)
- · Also, any sickness and any plague that is not written in the book of this Law, Yehowah will bring them upon you until you have been annihilated. (Deuteronomy 28:61)
- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; You yourselves have not obeyed me in keeping on proclaiming liberty each one to his brother and each one to his companion. Here I am proclaiming to you a liberty, is the utterance of Yehowah, to the sword, to the pestilence

and to the famine, and I shall certainly give you for a quaking to all the kingdoms of the earth. (Jeremiah 34:17)

- As for the one basket, the figs were very good, like early figs, and as for the other basket, the figs were very bad, so that they could not be eaten for badness. (Jeremiah 24:2)
- And like the bad figs that cannot be eaten for badness, this in fact is what Yehowah has said; So I shall give Zedekiah the king of Judah and his princes and the remnant of Jerusalem who are remaining over in this land and those who are dwelling in the land of Egypt. (Jeremiah 24:8)
- And I will scatter them among the nations that neither they nor their fathers have known, and I will send after them the sword until I shall have exterminated them. (Jeremiah 9:16)
- Better have those slain with the sword proved to be than those slain by famine, because these pine away, pierced through for lack of the produce of the open field. (Lamentations 4:9)
