- Woe to the **shepherds** who are destroying and scattering the sheep of my pasturage, is the utterance of **Yehowah**! (**Jeremiah 23:1**)
- There is a conspiracy of her prophets in the midst of her, like the roaring lion, tearing prey. A soul they actually devour. Treasure and precious things they keep taking. Her widows they have multiplied in the midst of her. (**Ezekiel 22:25**)
- Son of man, prophesy against the **shepherds** of Israel. Prophesy, and you must **say** to them, to the **shepherds**; This is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** has said; Woe to the **shepherds** of Israel, who have become feeders of themselves! Is it not the flock that the **shepherds** ought to feed? (**Ezekiel 34:2**)
- **You** haters of what is good and lovers of badness, tearing off their skin from people and their organism from off their bones. (**Micah 3:2**)
- Israel was something holy to **Yehowah**, the first yield to Him. Any persons devouring him would make themselves **guilty**. Calamity itself would come upon **them**, was the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 2:3**)
- Now there was a certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets that cried out to Elisha, saying; Your servant, my husband, is dead, and you yourself well know that your **own** servant had continually feared **Yehowah**, and the creditor himself has come to take both my children for his slaves. (**2 Kings 4:1**)

- And I proceeded to **say** to them; We ourselves have bought back our **own** Jewish brothers who were sold to the nations, as far as it was in our power, and at the same time will **you** yourselves sell **YOUR own** brothers, and must they be sold to us? At this they became speechless, and they did not find a word. (**Nehemiah 5:8**)
- And Ephraim keeps saying; Indeed, I have become rich, I have found valuable things for myself. As regards all my toiling, they will find, on my part, no error that is sin. (**Hosea 12:8**)
