- And as for the prophet, in case he gets fooled and actually speaks a word, I myself, **Yehowah**, **have** fooled that prophet, and I **will** stretch out my hand against him and annihilate him from the midst of my **people** Israel. (**Ezekiel 14:9**)
- So that is why God lets an operation of error go to them, that they may get to believing the lie. (**2 Thessalonians 2:11**)

distress upon a pregnant woman, and they **will** by no means escape. (**1 Thessalonians 5:3**)
