WICKED - HOLDS POOR IN DERISION

Men … Unrighteous … Holds Poor In Derision - He that holds a poor man in derision has reproached his maker, he that is joyful at another's disaster will not remain free from punishment (Proverbs 17:5) [13] - References

Proverbs 17:5. He that is holding the one of little means in derision has reproached his Maker. He that is joyful at another's disaster will not be free from punishment.

[13] - References

- He that is defrauding the lowly one has reproached his Maker, but the one showing favor to the poor one is glorifying Him. (Proverbs 14:31)
- If I used to rejoice at the extinction of one intensely hating me, or I felt excited because evil had found him. (Job 31:29)
- When your enemy falls, do not rejoice, and when he is caused to stumble, may your heart not be joyful. (Proverbs 24:17)
- And you ought not to watch the sight in the day of your brother, in the day of his misfortune, and you ought not to rejoice at the sons of Judah in the day of their perishing, and you ought not to maintain a big mouth in the day of their distress. (Obadiah 1:12)
- Rejoice with people who rejoice, weep with people who weep. (Romans 12:15)
- However, if he is lowly and does not have enough means, he must then take one young ram as a guilt offering for a wave offering in order to make atonement for him and one tenth of an ephah of fine flour moistened with oil as a grain offering and a log measure of oil. (Leviticus 14:21)
- And in case your brother grows poor and so he is financially weak alongside you, you must also sustain him. As an alien resident and a settler, he must keep alive with you. (Leviticus 25:35)

- But at my limping they rejoiced and gathered together, they gathered together against me, striking me down when I did not know it, they ripped me to pieces and did not keep silent. (Psalms 35:15)
- The man is good who is gracious and is lending. He sustains his affairs with justice. (Psalms 112:5)
- For the reason that this people has rejected the waters of the Shiloah that are going gently, and there is exultation over Rezin and the son of Remaliah. (Isaiah 8:6)
- For you men kept rejoicing, for you men kept exulting when pillaging my own inheritance. For you kept pawing like a heifer in the tender grass, and you kept neighing like stallions. (Jeremiah 50:11)
- And you must say concerning the sons of Ammon, Hear the word of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; For the reason that you have said; Aha! Against my sanctuary, because it has been profaned, and against the soil of Israel, because it has been laid desolate, and against the house of Judah, because they have gone into exile. (Ezekiel 25:3)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Certainly in the fire of my zeal I will speak against the remaining ones of the nations and against Edom, all of it, those who have given my land to themselves as a possession with the rejoicing of all the heart, with scorn in the soul, for the sake of its pasture ground and for the plunder.
