- Now after these things Jesus continued walking about in Galilee, for he did not want to walk about in Judea, because the **Jews** were seeking to kill him. (John 7:1)
- Moses gave **you** the Law, did he not? But not one of **you** obeys the Law. Why are **you** seeking to kill me? (John 7:19)
- But if I am doing them, even though **you** do not believe me, believe the works, in order, that **you** may come to know and may continue knowing that the **Father** is in union with me and I am in union with the **Father**. (John 10:38)
- **You** heard that I said to **you**, I am going away and I am coming back to **you**. If **you** loved me, **you** would rejoice that I am going my way to the **Father**, because the **Father** is greater than I am. (John 14:28)
- Who, although he was existing in God's form, gave no consideration to a seizure, namely, that he should be equal to God. (Philippians 2:6)
- But the Pharisees went out and took counsel against him that they might destroy him. (Matthew 12:14)
- He has put his trust in **God**, let Him now rescue him if He wants him, for he said; I am God's Son. (Matthew 27:43)
- Therefore some of the inhabitants of Jerusalem began to say; This is the man they are seeking to kill, is it not? (John 7:25)

- The **Jews** answered him; We are stoning you, not for a fine work, but for blasphemy, even because you, although being a man, make yourself a god. (**John 10:33**)
- Therefore from that day on they took counsel to **kill** him. (**John 11:53**)
- The **Jews** answered him; We have a Law, and according to the Law he ought to die, because he made himself God's son. (**John 19:7**)
