- Do save me, O Yehowah, for the loyal one has come to an end, for faithful people have vanished from the sons of men. (Psalms 12:1)
- The senseless one has said in his heart; There is no Yehowah. They have acted ruinously, they have acted detestably in their dealing. There is no one doing good. (Psalms 14:1)
- The righteous one himself has perished, but there is no one taking it to heart. And men of loving-kindness are being gathered to the dead, while no one discerns that it is because of the calamity that the righteous one has been gathered away. (Isaiah 57:1)
- Just as it is written: There is not a righteous man, not even one. (Romans 3:10)
- If they keep saying; Do go with us. Do let us lie in ambush for blood. Do let us lie in concealment for the innocent men without any cause. (Proverbs 1:11)
- For their feet are those that run to sheer badness, and they keep hastening to shed blood. (Proverbs 1:16)
- Their own feet keep running to sheer badness, and they are in a hurry to shed innocent blood. Their thoughts are hurtful thoughts, despoiling and breakdown are in their highways. (Isaiah 59:7)
- Their feet are speedy to shed blood. (Romans 3:15)
- And, my father, see, yes, see the skirt of your sleeveless coat in my hand, for when I cut off the skirt of your sleeveless coat I did not kill you. Know and see that there is no badness or revolt in my hand,

and I have not sinned against you, while you are lying in wait for my soul to take it away. (1 Samuel 24:11)

- A net they have prepared for my steps, my soul has become bowed down. They excavated before me a pitfall, they have fallen into the midst of it. (Psalms 57:6)
- All these he has brought up with a mere fishhook, he drags them away in his dragnet, and he gathers them in his fishing net. That is why he rejoices and is joyful. (Habakkuk 1:15)
- And Joab proceeded to say to Amasa; Is it all right with you, my brother? Then Joab's right hand took hold of Amasa's beard so as to kiss him. (2 Samuel 20:9)
- He keeps lying in wait in the concealed place like a lion in his covert. He keeps lying in wait to carry off some afflicted one by force. He carries off the afflicted one by force when he draws his net shut. (Psalms 10:9)
- The words of the wicked ones are a lying in wait for blood, but the mouth of the upright ones is what will deliver them. (Proverbs 12:6)
- The wicked one has desired the netted prey of bad men, but as for the root of the righteous ones, it yields. (Proverbs 12:12)
- A multitude of men will proclaim each one his own lovingkindness, but a faithful man who can find? (Proverbs 20:6)
- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They have left Yehowah, they have treated the Holy One of Israel with disrespect, they have turned backwards. (Isaiah 1:4)
- There is no one calling out in righteousness, and no one at all has gone to court in faithfulness. There has been a trusting in unreality, and a speaking of worthlessness. There has been a conceiving of trouble, and a bringing of what is hurtful to birth. (Isaiah 59:4)
- Go roving about in the streets of Jerusalem and see, now, and know, and seek for yourselves in her public squares whether you can find a man, whether there exists anyone doing justice, anyone seeking faithfulness, and I shall forgive her. (Jeremiah 5:1)
- And you must say to them; This is the nation whose people have not obeyed the voice of Yehowah its God, and have not taken

discipline. Faithfulness has perished, and it has been cut off from their mouth. (Jeremiah 7:28)

- Guard yourselves each one against his own companion, and put your trust in no brother at all. For even every brother would positively supplant, and every companion himself would walk around as a mere slanderer. (Jeremiah 9:4)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Woe to the city of deeds of bloodshed, the widemouthed cooking pot, the rust of which is in it, and the very rust of which has not gone forth from it! Piece by piece of it, bring it out, no lot must be cast over it. (Ezekiel 24:6)
- Hear the word of Yehowah, O sons of Israel, for Yehowah has a legal case with the inhabitants of the land, for there is no truth nor loving-kindness nor knowledge of God in the land. (Hosea 4:1)
- Hear this, O priests, and pay attention, O house of Israel, and You, O house of the king, give ear, for with You people the judgment has to do, because a trap is what You have become to Mizpah and as a net spread over Tabor. (Hosea 5:1)
- Gilead is a town of practicers of what is harmful, their footprints are blood. (Hosea 6:8)
- For her own rich men have become full of violence, and her own inhabitants have spoken falsehood, and their tongue is tricky in their mouth. (Micah 6:12)
- Is it not one father that all of us have? Is it not one God that has created us? Why is it that we deal treacherously with one another, in profaning the covenant of our forefathers? (Malachi 2:10)
