- He is an indecisive man, unsteady in all his ways. (James 1:8)
- Consequently the heart of the king of Syria became enraged over this matter, so that he called his servants and said to them; Will you not tell me who from those who belong to us is for the king of Israel? (2 Kings 6:11)
- He is stilling the noise of the seas, the noise of their waves and the turmoil of the national groups. (Psalms 65:7)
- For they do not sleep unless they do badness, and their sleep has been snatched away unless they cause someone to stumble. (Proverbs 4:16)
- For Damascus! Hamath and Arpad have become ashamed, for it is a bad report that they have heard. They have disintegrated. In the sea there is anxious care, it is not able to keep undisturbed. (Jeremiah 49:23)
