- He is stilling the noise of the **seas**, the noise of their waves and the turmoil of the national groups. **(Psalms 65:7)**
- For they do not sleep unless they do badness, and their sleep has been snatched away unless they cause someone to stumble. **(Proverbs 4:16)**
- For Damascus! Hamath and Arpad have become ashamed, for it is a bad report that they have heard. They have disintegrated. In the **sea** there is anxious care, it is not able to **keep** undisturbed. **(Jeremiah 49:23)**
- Daniel was speaking up and saying; I happened to be beholding in my visions during the night, and, see there! the four winds of the heavens were stirring up the vast **sea**. **(Daniel 7:2)**

- Also, there will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth anguish of nations, not knowing the way out because of the roaring of the **sea** and its agitation. (**Luke 21:25**)
- Wild waves of the **sea** that foam up their own causes for shame, stars with no set course, for which the blackness of darkness stands reserved forever. (**Jude 1:13**)
- And the second angel blew his trumpet. And something like a great mountain burning with fire was hurled into the **sea**. And a third of the **sea** became blood. (**Revelation 8:8**)
- On this account be glad, **you** heavens and **you** who reside in them! Woe for the earth and for the **sea**, because the Devil has come **down** to **you**, having great anger, knowing he has a short period of time. (**Revelation 12:12**)
- And it stood still upon the sand of the **sea**. And I saw a wild beast ascending out of the **sea**, with ten horns and seven heads, and upon its horns ten diadems, but upon its heads blasphemous names. (**Revelation 13:1**)
- And the second one poured out his bowl into the **sea**. And it became blood as of a dead man, and every living soul died, yes, the things in the **sea**. (**Revelation 16:3**)
- And one of the seven angels that had the seven bowls came and spoke with me, saying; Come, I will show you the judgment upon the great harlot who sits on many **waters**. (**Revelation 17:1**)
- And he says to me; The **waters** that you saw, where the harlot is sitting, mean peoples and crowds and nations and tongues. (**Revelation 17:15**)
- And I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the former heaven and the former earth had passed away, and the **sea** is no more. (**Revelation 21:1**)
