

## WICKED - LIKE USELESS CHAFF

**Psalms 1:4**... The wicked are not like that, but are like the chaff that the wind drives away.

- Do they become like straw before a **wind**, and like **chaff** that a storm **wind** has stolen **away**? (**Job 21:18**)
- May they become like **chaff** before the **wind**, and let Yehowah's angel be pushing them along. (**Psalms 35:5**)
- The national groups themselves will make a din just like the noise of many waters. And He will certainly rebuke it, and it must flee far **away** and be chased like the **chaff** of the mountains before a **wind** and like a thistle whirl before a storm **wind**. (**Isaiah 17:13**)
- His winnowing shovel is in his hand, and he will completely clean up his threshing floor, and will gather his wheat into the storehouse, but the **chaff** he will burn up with fire that cannot be put out. (**Matthew 3:12**)
- But the transgressors themselves will certainly be annihilated together, the future of wicked people will indeed be cut off. (**Psalms 37:38**)
- And the crowd of those strange to you must become just like fine powder, and the crowd of the tyrants just like the **chaff** that is passing **away**. And it must occur in an instant, suddenly. (**Isaiah 29:5**)
- All the nations are as something nonexistent in front of him, as nothing and an unreality they have been accounted to him. (**Isaiah 40:17**)
- Look! I have made you a threshing sledge, a new threshing instrument having double-edged teeth. You will tread down the mountains and crush them, and the hills you will make just like the **chaff**. (**Isaiah 41:15**)

- When you cry for aid your collection of things will not deliver you, but a **wind** will carry even all of them **away**. An exhalation will take them **away**, but the one taking refuge in me will inherit the land and will take possession of my holy mountain. (**Isaiah 57:13**)
- And we become like someone unclean, all of us, and all our acts of righteousness are like a garment for periods of menstruation, and we shall fade **away** like leafage, all of us, and our errors themselves will carry us **away** just like a **wind**. (**Isaiah 64:6**)
- So I shall scatter them like stubble that is passing along in the **wind** from the wilderness. (**Jeremiah 13:24**)
- And I shall winnow them with a fork in the gates of the land. I shall certainly bereave them of children. I will destroy my people, since they have not turned back from their own ways. (**Jeremiah 15:7**)
- At that time the iron, the molded clay, the copper, the silver and the gold were, all together, crushed and became like the **chaff** from the summer threshing floor, and the **wind** carried them **away** so that no trace at all was found of them. And as for the stone that struck the image, it became a large mountain and filled the whole earth. (**Daniel 2:35**)
- Therefore they will become like the clouds of morning and like the dew that early goes **away**, like **chaff** that is stormed **away** from the threshing floor and like smoke from the roof hole. (**Hosea 13:3**)
- His winnowing shovel is in his hand to clean up his threshing floor completely and to gather the wheat into his storehouse, but the **chaff** he will burn up with fire that cannot be put out. (**Luke 3:17**)
