- But Peter **said**; Ananias, why **has** Satan emboldened you to play false to the Holy Spirit and to hold back secretly some of the price of the field? (**Acts of Apostles 5:3**)
- For **Yehowah**, the Most High, is **fear-inspiring**, a **great** King over all the earth. (**Psalms 47:2**)
- But **Yehowah** is in truth God. He is the living God and the King to time indefinite. Because of his indignation the earth **will** rock, and no nations **will** hold up under his denunciation. (**Jeremiah 10:10**)
- And I began to pray to **Yehowah** my God and to make confession and to say; Ah **Yehowah** the true God, the **great** One and the **fear-inspiring** One, keeping the covenant and the loving-kindness to those loving him and to those keeping his commandments. (**Daniel 9:4**)
- He **will** humble the spirit of leaders, **fear-inspiring** he is to the kings of the earth. (**Psalms 76:12**)
- Who **will** not really fear you, **Yehowah**, and glorify your **name**, because you alone are loyal? For all the nations **will** come and worship before you, because your righteous decrees have been made manifest. (**Revelation 15:4**)
- So Esau **said** to Jacob; Quick, please, give me a swallow of the red, the red there, for I **am** tired! That is why his **name** was called Edom. (**Genesis 25:30**)

- The sheep should prove to be sound, a **male**, a year old, for **you**. **you** may pick from the young rams or from the goats. (**Exodus 12:5**)
- If his offering is a burnt offering from the herd, a **male**, a sound one, is what he should present. At the entrance of the tent of meeting he should present it of his own free **will** before **Yehowah**. (**Leviticus 1:3**)
- And if his offering for a burnt offering is from the flock, from the young rams or the goats, a **male**, a sound one, is what he **will** present. (**Leviticus 1:10**)
- This is a statute of the Law that **Yehowah has** commanded, saying; Speak to the sons of Israel that they should take for you a sound red cow in which there is no defect and upon which no yoke **has** come. (**Numbers 19:2**)
- For **Yehowah** is a **great** God and a **great** King over all other gods. (**Psalms 95:3**)
- He **has** sent redemption itself to his people. To time indefinite he **has** commanded his covenant. His **name** is holy and **fear-inspiring**. (**Psalms 111:9**)
- As I **am** alive, is the utterance of the King, whose **name** is **Yehowah** of **armies**, like Tabor **among** the mountains and like Carmel by the sea he **will** come in. (**Jeremiah 46:18**)
- Moab **has** been despoiled, and one **has** gone up against her own cities. And their choicest young men themselves have gone down to the slaughtering, is the utterance of the King, whose **name** is **Yehowah** of **armies**. (**Jeremiah 48:15**)
- And I **will** make her princes and her wise ones, her governors and her deputy rulers and her mighty men drunk, and they must sleep an indefinitely lasting sleep, from which they **will** not wake up, is the utterance of the King, whose **name** is **Yehowah** of **armies**. (**Jeremiah 51:57**)
