Men … Unrighteous … Sentence Withheld - Because sentence against a bad work is executed slowly it emboldens the bad to do even worse (Ecclesiastes 8:11) [20] - References

Ecclesiastes 8:11... Because sentence against a bad work has not been executed speedily, that is why the heart of the sons of men has become fully set in them to do bad.

- When Pharaoh got to see that relief had taken place, he made his heart unresponsive, and he did not listen to them, just as Yehowah had spoken. (Exodus 8:15)
- And he used to say to them; Why do you keep doing things like these? For the things I am hearing about you from all the people are bad. (1 Samuel 2:23)
- He has said in his heart; I shall not be made to totter, for generation after generation I shall be one who is in no calamity. (Psalms 10:6)
- Though the wicked one should be shown favor, he simply will not learn righteousness. In the land of straighforwardness he will act unjustly and will not see the eminence of Yehowah. (Isaiah 26:10)
- But if ever that evil slave should say in his heart; My master is delaying. (Matthew 24:48)
- But, in fact, for this cause I have kept you in existence, for the sake of showing you my power and in order to have my name declared in all the earth. (Exodus 9:16)
- But we shall positively do every word that has gone forth from our mouth, in order to make sacrificial smoke to the queen of the heavens' and to pour out to her drink offerings, just as we ourselves and our forefathers, our kings and our princes did in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, when we used to be satisfied with bread and to be well off, and we did not see any calamity at all.
