~ **Men ... Unrighteous ... Regressing** - You have deserted me and your progress is backwards, therefore I shall stretch out my hand against you to bring you to ruin for I am tired of feeling regrets' **(Jeremiah 15:6)** ^[12] - References

Jeremiah 15:6· You yourself have deserted me, is the utterance of Yehowah. Backwards is the way you keep walking. And I shall stretch out my hand against you and bring you to ruin. I have got tired of feeling regret.

^[12] - References

- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They **have** left **Yehowah**, they **have** treated the Holy One of Israel with disrespect, they **have** turned backwards. **(Isaiah 1:4)**
- But they did not listen, neither did they incline their ear, but they went **walking** in the counsels in the stubbornness of their bad heart, so that they became backward in direction and not forward. **(Jeremiah 7:24)**
- Therefore here I am, I **have** stretched **out** my **hand against** you, and I will give you as something to plunder to the nations, and I will cut you off from the peoples and destroy you from the lands. I shall annihilate you, and you will **have** to know that I am **Yehowah**. **(Ezekiel 25:7)**
- And I will **stretch out** my **hand against** Judah and **against** all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and I will cut off from this place the remaining ones of the Baal, the name of the foreign-god priests along with the priests. **(Zephaniah 1:4)**
- The anger of **Yehowah** will not turn back until he will **have** carried **out** and until he will **have** made the ideas of his heart come true. In the final part of the days **you** people will give **YOUR** consideration to it with understanding. **(Jeremiah 23:20)**
- I myself, **Yehowah**, **have** spoken. It must come, and I will act. I shall not neglect, neither shall I feel sorry nor feel **regret**. According to

your **ways** and according to your dealings they will certainly judge you, is the **utterance** of the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**. (**Ezekiel 24:14**)

- From the **hand** of Sheol I shall redeem them, from death I shall recover them. Where are your stings, O Death? Where is your destructiveness, O Sheol? Compassion itself will be concealed from my eyes. (**Hosea 13:14**)

- They **have** acted ruinously on their own part, They are not his children, the defect is their own. A generation crooked and twisted! (**Deuteronomy 32:5**)

- The Egyptians, though, are earthling men, and not God, and their horses are flesh, and not spirit. And **Yehowah** himself will **stretch out** his **hand**, and he that is offering help will **have** to stumble, and he that is being helped will **have** to fall, and at the same time they will all of them come to an end. (**Isaiah 31:3**)

- For the reason that they **have** left me and **have** proceeded to make this place unrecognizable and to make sacrificial smoke in it to other gods whom they had not known, they and their forefathers and the kings of Judah, and they **have** filled this place with the blood of the innocent ones. (**Jeremiah 19:4**)

- Then **Yehowah** said to me; What are you seeing, Amos? So I said; A plummet. And **Yehowah** went on to say; Here I am setting a plummet in the midst of my people Israel. I shall no more do any further excusing of it. (**Amos 7:8**)

- **You** people **have** made **Yehowah** weary by **YOUR** words, and **YOU have** said; In what **way have** we made him weary? By **YOUR** saying; Everyone that is doing bad is good in the eyes of **Yehowah**, and in such ones he himself has taken delight, or, Where is the God of justice? (**Malachi 2:17**)
