• And to David the report was made, saying; Ahithophel himself is among those conspiring with Absalom. At this David said; Turn, please, the counsel of Ahithophel into foolishness, O Yehowah! (**2 Samuel 15:31**)

• And going straight up to Jesus he said; Good day, Rabbi! And kissed him very tenderly. (**Matthew 26:49**)

• Accordingly Jonathan spoke well of David to Saul his father and said to him; Do not let the king sin against his servant David, for he has not sinned toward you and his works have been very good toward you. (**1 Samuel 19:4**)

• I am distressed over you, my **brother** Jonathan, very pleasant you were to me. More wonderful was your love to me than the love from women. (**2 Samuel 1:26**)

• And David proceeded to say; Is there yet anyone that is left over of the house of Saul, that I may exercise loving-kindness toward him for the sake of Jonathan? (**2 Samuel 9:1**)

• A true companion is loving all the time, and is a **brother** that is born for when there is distress. (**Proverbs 17:17**)

• The one covering over transgression is seeking love, and he that keeps talking about a matter is separating those familiar with one another. (**Proverbs 17:9**)

• At that they raised their voices and wept some more, after which Orpah kissed her mother-in-law. As for Ruth, she stuck with her. (**Ruth 1:14**)

- And Jonathan and David proceeded to conclude a covenant, because of his loving him as his own soul. (1 Samuel 18:3)
- As for Jonathan, Saul's son, he took great delight in David. So Jonathan told David, saying; Saul my father is seeking to have you put to death. And now be on your guard, please, in the morning, and you must dwell in secrecy and keep yourself hidden. (1 Samuel 19:2)
- So Jonathan swore again to David because of his love for him, for as he loved his own soul he loved him. (1 Samuel 20:17)
- However, Jonathan answered Saul his father and said to him; Why should he be put to death? What has he done? (1 Samuel 20:32)
- At this the king's servants said to the king; According to all that my lord the king may choose, here are your servants. (2 Samuel 15:15)
- But Ittai answered the king and said; As Yehowah is living and as my lord the king is living, in the place where my lord the king may come to be, whether for death or for life, there is where your servant will come to be! (2 Samuel 15:21)
- At this Absalom said to Hushai; This is the loving-kindness of yours toward your companion, is it? Why did you not go with your companion? (2 Samuel 16:17)
- And Elijah began to say to Elisha; Sit here, please, because Yehowah himself has sent me clear to Bethel. But Elisha said; As Yehowah is living and as your soul is living, I will not leave you. So they went down to Bethel. (2 Kings 2:2)
- These ten times **you** proceeded to rebuke me, **you** are not ashamed that **you** deal so hard with me. (Job 19:3)
