Men … Unrighteous … Run To Badness, Shedders Of Blood -Their feet run to sheer badness and they keep hastening to shed blood (Proverbs 1:16) [14] - References

Proverbs 1:16. For their feet are those that run to sheer badness, and they keep hastening to shed blood.

[14] - References

- For they do not sleep unless they do badness, and their sleep has been snatched away unless they cause someone to stumble. (Proverbs 4:16)
- A heart fabricating hurtful schemes, feet that are in a hurry to run to badness. (Proverbs 6:18)
- Also, that the soul should be without knowledge is not good, and he that is hastening with his feet is sinning. (Proverbs 19:2)
- Lofty eyes, a false tongue, and hands that are shedding innocent blood. (Proverbs 6:17)
- Their own feet keep running to sheer badness, and they are in a hurry to shed innocent blood. Their thoughts are hurtful thoughts, despoiling and breakdown are in their highways. (Isaiah 59:7)
- Their feet are speedy to shed blood. (Romans 3:15)
- And Absalom rose up early and stood at the side of the road to the gate. And it came about, when any man happened to have a legal case to come to the king for judgment, then Absalom would call him and say; From what city are you? And he would say; From one of the tribes of Israel your servant is. (2 Samuel 15:2)
- And Ahithophel proceeded to say to Absalom; Let me choose, please, twelve thousand men and rise up and chase after David tonight. (2 Samuel 17:1)
- Though there is no error, they run and get themselves ready. Do rouse yourself at my calling and see. (Psalms 59:4)

- But it occurred that as soon as they came into the midst of the city, Ishmael the son of Nethaniah went slaughtering them and throwing them into the midst of the cistern, he and the men that were with him. (Jeremiah 41:7)
- The loyal one has perished from the earth, and among mankind there is no upright one. All of them, for bloodshed they lie in wait. They hunt, everyone his own brother, with a dragnet. (Micah 7:2)
- The chief priests now took counsel to kill Lazarus also. (John 12:10)
- Above all things, do not let them persuade you, for more than forty men of theirs are lying in wait for him, and they have bound themselves with a curse neither to eat nor to drink until they have done away with him, and they are now ready, waiting for the promise from you. (Acts of Apostles 23:21)
- Asking for themselves as a favor against the man that he would send for him to come to Jerusalem, as they were laying an ambush to do away with him along the road. (Acts of Apostles 25:3)
