## **WICKED - SOON WILL BE NO MORE**

Men … Unrighteous … Wicked Ones - Just a little while longer and the wicked one will be no more, you will look around for him and he will not be anymore (Psalms 37:10) [27] - References

Psalms 37:10... And just a little while longer, and the wicked one will be no more, and you will certainly give attention to his place, and he will not be.

[27] - References

- They have become high up a little while, then they are no more, and they have been brought low, like everyone else they are plucked off, and like the head of an ear of grain they are cut off. (Job 24:24)
- For yet a very little while, and he who is coming will arrive and will not delay. (Hebrews 10:37)
- But the end of all things has drawn close. Be sound in mind, therefore, and be vigilant with a view to prayers. (1 Peter 4:7)
- · And David got to hear that Nabal had died, and so he said; Blessed be Yehowah, who has conducted the legal case of my reproach to free me from Nabal's hand and has kept his servant back from badness, and the badness of Nabal Yehowah has turned back upon his own head! And David proceeded to send and propose to Abigail to take her as his wife. (1 Samuel 25:39)
- He will not return anymore to his house, and his place will not acknowledge him anymore. (Job 7:10)
- God himself will also pull you down forever, he will knock you down and tear you away from your tent, and he will certainly root you out of the land of the living ones. (Psalms 52:5)
- It is unthinkable of you that you are acting in this manner to put to death the righteous man with the wicked one so that it has to occur with the righteous man as it does with the wicked! It is unthinkable of you. Is the Judge of all the earth not going to do what is right? (Genesis 18:25)

- But good-for-nothing persons are chased away, like thornbushes, all of them, for it is not by the hand that they should be taken. (2 Samuel 23:6)
- The face of Yehowah is against those doing what is bad, to cut off the mention of them from the very earth. (Psalms 34:16)
- And yet he proceeded to pass away, and there he was not, and I kept seeking him, and he was not found. (Psalms 37:36)
- Surely on slippery ground is where you place them. You have made them fall to ruins. (Psalms 73:18)
- The sinners will be finished off from the earth, and as for the wicked, they will be no longer. Bless Yehowah, O my soul. Praise Yah, you people! (Psalms 104:35)
- As when the storm wind passes over, so the wicked one is no more, but the righteous one is a foundation to time indefinite. (Proverbs 10:25)
- No man will be firmly established by wickedness, but as for the root-foundation of the righteous ones, it will not be caused to stagger. (Proverbs 12:3)
- There is an overthrowing of the wicked ones and they are no more, but the very house of the righteous ones will keep standing. (Proverbs 12:7)
- The Righteous One is giving consideration to the house of the wicked one, subverting the wicked ones to their calamity. (Proverbs 21:12)
- But it will not turn out well at all with the wicked one, neither will he prolong his days that are like a shadow, because he is not in fear of God. (Ecclesiastes 8:13)
- The whole earth has come to rest, has become free of disturbance. People have become cheerful with joyful cries. (Isaiah 14:7)
- You will search for them, but you will not find them, those men in a struggle with you. They will become as something nonexistent and as nothing, those men at war with you. (Isaiah 41:12)
- As for merchants among the peoples, they will certainly whistle over you. Sudden terrors are what you must become, and you will be no more to time indefinite. (Ezekiel 27:36)

- At that time the iron, the molded clay, the copper, the silver and the gold were, all together, crushed and became like the chaff from the summer threshing floor, and the wind carried them away so that no trace at all was found of them. And as for the stone that struck the image, it became a large mountain and filled the whole earth. (Daniel 2:35)
