Job 21:14 And they say to the true God, Turn away from us! And in the knowledge of your ways we have found no delight.

- Who are saying to the **true God**; **Turn away** from us! And what can the Almighty accomplish against us? (**Job 22:17**)
- He has said in his heart; God has forgotten. He has concealed his face. He will certainly never see it. (**Psalms 10:11**)
- And they **have** said; How has **God** come to know? And does there exist **knowledge** in the Most High? (**Psalms 73:11**)
- Now this is the basis for judgment, that the light has come into the world but men **have** loved the darkness rather than the light, for their works were wicked. (**John 3:19**)
- And just as they did not approve of holding **God** in accurate **knowledge**, **God** gave them up to a disapproved mental state, to do the things not fitting. (**Romans 1:28**)
- Have none of the practicers of what is hurtful got **knowledge**, eating up my people as they **have** eaten bread? They **have** not called even upon Yehowah. (**Psalms 53:4**)
- Therefore haughtiness has served as a necklace to them, violence envelops them as a garment. (**Psalms 73:6**)
- Who say things about you according to their idea, they **have** taken up your name in a worthless way, your adversaries. (**Psalms 139:20**)
- The ridiculer does not love the one reproving him. To the wise ones he will not go. (**Proverbs 15:12**)
- And from the time that we ceased to make sacrificial smoke to the queen of the heavens and pour out drink offerings to her we **have**

lacked everything, and by the sword and by the famine we **have** come to our finish. (**Jeremiah 44:18**)
