WICKED - THINK - GOD DOES NOT SEE ALL

Men … Unrighteous … Think God Does Not See All - His heart reasons, God has forgotten, he's not looking on, he will not see me (Psalms 10:11) [14] - References

Psalms 10:11" He has said in his heart; God has forgotten. He has concealed his face. He will certainly never see it.

[14] - References

- He has said in his heart; I shall not be made to totter, for generation after generation I shall be one who is in no calamity. (Psalms 10:6)
- Now there were some of the scribes there, sitting and reasoning in their hearts. (Mark 2:6)
- They hold themselves down to bad speech, they make statements about hiding traps. They have said; Who sees them? (Psalms 64:5)
- Because sentence against a bad work has not been executed speedily, that is why the heart of the sons of men has become fully set in them to do bad. (Ecclesiastes 8:11)
- Conceal your face from my sins, and wipe out even all my errors. (Psalms 51:9)
- And they have said; How has God come to know? And does there exist knowledge in the Most High? (Psalms 73:11)
- And they keep saying; Yah does not see, and the God of Jacob does not understand it. (Psalms 94:7)
- And he proceeded to say to me; Have you seen, O son of man, what the elderly ones of the house of Israel are doing in the darkness, each one in the inner rooms of his showpiece? For they are saying; Yehowah is not seeing us. Yehowah has left the land. (Ezekiel 8:12)
