**Psalms 10:11** He has said in his heart; God has forgotten. He has concealed his face. He will certainly never see it.

- He **has said** in his **heart**; I shall not be made to totter, for generation after generation I shall be one who is in no calamity. **(Psalms 10:6)**
- Now there were some of the scribes there, sitting and reasoning in their **hearts**. **(Mark 2:6)**
- They hold themselves down to bad speech, they make statements about hiding traps. They have **said**; Who **sees** them? **(Psalms 64:5)**
- Because sentence against a bad work **has** not been executed speedily, that is why the **heart** of the sons of men **has** become fully set in them to do bad. **(Ecclesiastes 8:11)**
- Conceal your **face** from my sins, and wipe out even all my errors. **(Psalms 51:9)**
- And they have **said**; How **has** God come to know? And does there exist knowledge in the Most High? **(Psalms 73:11)**
- And they keep saying; Yah does not **see**, and the God of Jacob does not understand **it**. **(Psalms 94:7)**
- And he proceeded to say to me; Have you seen, O son of man, what the elderly ones of the house of Israel are doing in the darkness, each one in the inner rooms of his showpiece? For they are saying; Yehowah is not seeing us. Yehowah **has** left the land. **(Ezekiel 8:12)**
- So he **said** to me; The error of the house of Israel and Judah is very, very great, and the land is filled with bloodshed and the city is full of crookedness, for they have **said**; Yehowah **has** left the land, and Yehowah is not seeing. **(Ezekiel 9:9)**

- When I got to **see** among the spoil an official garment from Shinar, a good-looking one, and two hundred shekels of silver and one gold bar, fifty shekels being its weight, then I wanted them, and I took them, and, look! They are hidden in the earth in the midst of my tent with the money underneath **it**. (**Joshua 7:21**)
- And the messenger that went to call Micaiah spoke to him, saying; Look! The words of the prophets are unanimously of good to the king, and let your word, please, become like one of them and you must speak good. (**2 Chronicles 18:12**)
- And they say to the true God, Turn away from us! And in the knowledge of your ways we have found no delight. (**Job 21:14**)
